Brotherhood: We were strangers when we went. . . But we were Brothers when we returned...

Who are you? We are 'in country' veterans of the Vietnam War, each of us having served at least one tour of duty in Vietnam. We have all earned the Vietnam Service Medal, & our membership includes representatives from each of the Armed Forces of the United States. We represent all races & ethnic groups, & we enjoy the camaraderie of our brothers in arms, & the healing & friendship of being with others who've shared the same experiences.

What are you? The In Country MC is a wholly benevolent not-for-profit federally tax-exempt war veterans motorcycle club. Our motto is "Vets Helping Vets" & our purpose is to provide moral, mental, & physical support to our brothers & sisters as well as other veterans, their families, widows, & children. We may also assist other members of the community who need financial, emotional, & personal support. We are always there with a "Welcome Home - Job Well Done!" for the Vietnam veteran who has never heard it from the public or family who didn't want to recognize his participation in the war. Each chapter has a chosen veterans cause they must support through annual fund raising events & charitable work.

Why? We exist because there is a need for US!

How do I join? Contact any In Country MC Brother & ask him.

Club History: The In Country Vets MC was conceived & founded in late 1994 by a small group of Vietnam Veterans in Illinois who had served in country, & wanted to ride together in a motorcycling brotherhood with a desire to support & assist each other, other veterans, veterans widows & dependents, & other members of the community. The club is wholly benevolent in purpose & organization. Following appropriate protocols, the founders met with the senior clubs in their area & received approval to wear the patch they had designed - an In Country Vets top rocker, a stylized version of the Vietnam Service Medal as a center patch, an MC patch, & their unit ID as a bottom rocker. A Constitution & Bylaws were drawn up, & the club was incorporated as a not-for-profit war veterans MC in Illinois. In line with their motto of "Vets Helping Vets", they applied for, & were granted an IRS 501c (19) Fed tax exempt status. In the more than ten years since the club was founded, it has grown to include members, chapters, & charters all over the U.S., & in 2002, the first Internat'l chapter was formed, comprised of Vietnam veterans living in Germany.

Alabama Confederation of Motorcycle Clubs: The Alabama Confederation Of Motorcycle Clubs, exists to provide All motorcyclists a unified voice through the judicial system against instances of harassment & discrimination. If you believe you have been unjustly harassed or discriminated against simply because you ride a motorcycle, wear motorcycle oriented "biker" clothing, or associate with other like-minded individuals in motorcycling organizations, please contact the ALCOC.

History ALCOC: Originally formed as the AL/MS COC following an exploratory meeting in Jackson MS in November 1996, the combined COC split in 1998, & the Alabama Confederation of Motorcycle Clubs was born. Conceived more than a dozen years ago, the COC format provides for a coming together of motorcycle clubs, organizations & associations within the state for the specific purposes of combating discrimination & harassment through judicial means. Membership is open to all motorcycle clubs, organizations & associations, without regard to patch, brand, or affiliation. The ALCOC meets quarterly in different locations around the state to provide members the opportunity to present complaints of harassment or discrimination, as well as socialize. Our COC Attorney, present at all meetings, represents the member clubs & groups in claims of harassment or discrimination. If you ride a motorcycle & have been harassed either by law enforcement or at a public business establishment; or if you have been discriminated against because you were either riding a motorcycle or wearing "motorcycle attire" (leathers, "biker" t-shirts, etc.), please contact the ALCOC for information on attending our next meeting & presenting your claim. The ALCOC invites your participation in helping preserve the right to freedom of association, dress, & mode of transportation. Celebrating 18 Successful Years - 1996 - 2014...

Get Involved: If you ride with an MC, group, organization, or association, & you're not a member of the ALCOC, please contact any of the members for information on joining. All MC's, riding clubs, associations, etc., are eligible for membership & your active participation is welcomed & encouraged. All motorcyclists have been or will be discriminated against or harassed at one time or another. It's Illegal & you can do something about it! Talk to your members now, & join the Alabama Confederation of MC s. Help preserve your civil rights & freedoms as motorcyclists.

Independent ALCOC Membership: The ALCOC has been offering independent memberships, due to the fact that we did not have an organized, functioning Motorcycle Rights Organization in the state. We now have a viable MRO in Alabama, "Dixie ABATE", & we have included a page for them on our website, along with a link to their membership form. Current independent ALCOC members who want to continue their membership may; however, we are going to ask that they, & other independent riders consider joining Dixie ABATE. They are the organization truly designed to handle the legislative side of motorcycle rights, while the COC handles the discrimination & harassment problems.

Devils Diciples MC - <http://www.DevilsDiciples.org/> - **Home / Welcome Page:** Welcome to our National Website: We are the Devils Diciples MC; we intentionally mis-spell "Disciples" to distance ourselves from religious attachments & to set us apart from all the others that use variations of our name spelled correctly. We are an outlaw type club being that we do what we want with who we want & do not follow typical American Motorcycle Association Guidelines. We are also a family that includes our wives & children as well as other "blood relatives" within our scope of operation but exclude them from actually being members with the rights membership entitles. We also generally stay to ourselves & focus on our own parties & events rather than making a regular showing in public. We are not a criminal organization; our members are required to have jobs, H-Ds & are free of drug or alcohol addictions. We attempt to be the

catalyst that not only enhances our member's lives through Brotherhood & riding motorcycles; but to also work together to better the club & our individual lives. We Ride our motorcycles & are constantly traveling Coast to Coast 24/7...

History: We the Devils Diciples MC began our life in Fontana, CA in 1967. We began with 6 original brothers who designed a "wheel & trident" center patch with 6 spokes for the original members, but realized that 6 spokes will not complete a wheel, so they doubled it to 12 spokes & ended up with our center patch. Since then we have believed that we had 12 original members. Now you know the truth. A wheel cannot roll with only 6 spokes! (Per Fat Dog)... In 1969 the Michigan chapter began, & us picking up the "Paladins" in , Alabama (Dog the Bounty Hunter was a member back then), also West Virginia, Ontario "Windsor" Canada, Kentucky. The Nomads came in near the same time & Ohio followed in 1970. Twilight also worked on a chapter in Oklahoma but the establishment became too much to deal with & we shut it down. In 1977 The East met the West & we joined with the California brothers standardizing the patch to leather & the FTW on the right side. The Arizona chapter was started in end of the 70's. By the end of the 70's & early 80's we picked up the "Gladiators" in Indiana, started by Chino & JC with "Chino" as the President. We also had a chapter in Oregon but it was closed due to un-worthiness. Another piece of our history is an associate of ours called "Ugly Bill" who has been a part of many a good time & party; luv ya bro. We have brothers (some retired) in about every State in the Union & Canada since the beginning & always will. DFFD...

Club History: The Club came into existence on the north side of Dublin in the late 1970s & officially formed in 1979. In 1980 the Club started to attract membership & this formed the nucleus & traditions of the Club still evident to this present day. In the 80s, members had to have a motorcycle of 350cc or bigger as all members rode British machines mostly Triumphs. This was due to the fact of the "No Jap Crap" rule (a self-imposed embargo on Japanese machinery) & Harleys just were not a realistic option due to cost & availability. In fact it would take until 1984 before the first Harley would take to the roads under the Club Colors. The original Club Colors were Red & White. These Colors were to serve the Club well into 1986 when we made a design change & changed the Colors to Black & White. This change was made to distance ourselves from associations with International Clubs & to serve notice to the other existing Irish Clubs that we had no such connections & were willing to coexist with them. These Colours served us from 1986 - 1996. Over this ten year period, many changes were happening in the Irish Club scene & the Devils Disciples MC were a club in the midst of a lot of this. Within the Club, some Members got involved in the bar trade, & whilst this provided employment for some Club Members, the

pub always served as a focal point for the custom bike scene in Dublin. Names such as Barnstormers, Fusion & The Old Barn still evoke fond memories in bikers who were on the scene during the Ninties. It was during this period, we established our first club house, started running gigs regularly & organized our first Show. The 1st "Black Hills Custom & Classic Bike Show" was held in the Man 'O War pub in North County Dublin in September 1992 & was a big success, to its credit this Show has gone from strength to strength, but is no longer the venue for this Show. This show is now held every year during the first weekend of July, & it has earned a reputation as a laid back relaxed sort of Show, featuring dancing girls, trade stalls, tattoo artists, a very good selection of bands & of course the bikes. This Show is the only remaining 3 Day Event left on the Irish Show Circuit, & it holds a special place in the hearts of bikers & locals alike as the place to be before, during & after the Skerries 100 Road Race which coincides with our Show. It was during this time the Club expanded in terms of numbers of Members. It was also during this time the Club Members started to make the transition from British bikes to American ones, for various reasons; the recession of the early 80s was coming to an end, Harleys were still very expensive, but finally attainable. British bikes such as Triumph had served their purpose, but with bikes becoming older & more unreliable, together with increasing difficulty in acquiring the parts to maintain them, the die was cast, within 5 years the Club was exclusively Harley. The "No Jap Crap" rule stayed in place. No one can accuse the Devils Disciples MC of being complacent, & in 1996 it was decided to change the Colors for a final time. This took some time to sort, but eventually we decided to go with the design that is still worn today- the Green & the Gold, were the Colours chosen leaving no doubt as to the Clubs Irish roots. From 1996 the Club went through a few more transitional changes. The "No Jap Crap" rule was lifted, provided the bike was customized or chopped, definitely no stock bikes though. A new cc limit was brought in, it was now 750cc reflecting the engine capacity of American, European & Japanese machines, it was also upped to 500 cc for British bikes. The Club continued to grow, establishing Chapters in Wicklow, as a result of a long friendship with the Clan MCC who came on board in 1998 & Kildare as well as the North West. The Club went through a series of Club Houses before settling into our current location. A second Show was established in 1998. This Show is known as "The Gathering" & was held in The Gap Bar in Co. Wicklow. This Show is a 2 Day Event & is similar in format to "The Black Hills" in its scope & entertainment. The Shows location was then moved the Bunker Bar in Gorey, Co. Wexford. Good time's aside, it is the Bike Show on Sunday that provides the focus. In 2006, the Club continued its policy of friendship with Irish MCC's & as a result of this another MCC called the Loonies from Dublin decided to make the transition & become Devils Disciples. This policy of Friendship is still core to our beliefs, as witnessed by our continued support of MCC shows & rallies around the country. This Club was a founding Member Club of the Alliance, the Organization of Irish MCs, & is proud to wear this Patch on our own Colors. This Club has had a distinguished & turbulent history, but taking our 1% beliefs with experience gained, we look forward to growing further & as a Partner in the Irish Alliance into a bigger & better Club ready to face any new challenges that come along in the future.

Police arrest one in rally weekend shooting, suspect biker clubs quarreled – July 6, 2014 – *Hollister, California* – By Kollin Kosmicki; www.SanBenitoCountyToday.com - Police made one arrest in a Sunday shooting that involved 3 victims at a Chevron gas station during the Hollister Rally motorcycle event, while investigators suspect 2 rival "motorcycle clubs" were involved, the police chief reported Sunday afternoon. The status remains unclear for 3 victims of gunshot wounds in a shooting that occurred Sunday morning at the Chevron gas station on San Felipe Road during the Hollister Rally. The incident was reported at 10:36 a.m. at 631 San Felipe Rd near Hwy 25 entering the city, said Police Chief David Westrick. Police responded to the shooting on the third & final day of the Hollister Rally motorcycle event & found the 3 victims of gunshot wounds & another victim of assault. As of a 3 p.m. press briefing, the status of the victims remained unclear. The police Dept had patrols – "beefed up" for the rally – in the area at the time of the shooting. "The response was actually quite quick," the chief said. "We actually had

officers in the area at the time." He said police were questioning the suspect in the afternoon & they would transport him to the San Benito County Jail. Westrick said it appeared the shooting involved visitors here for the rally – & added that investigators suspect members from 2 unspecified biker "clubs" were involved. The gas station is about a mile & a half from the rally event area in downtown Hollister. Investigators believe a dispute Saturday night continued into Sunday when the 2 sides crossed paths at the gas station. The 2 rival clubs had a physical altercation Saturday in the event area, & one member was arrested on suspicion of possessing a dirk or dagger, according to a police statement released Sunday night. Hollister Fire Dept & ambulance responders treated the victims on scene & had them flown to a Bay Area hospital. Police are continuing to work on solidifying leads. "We do have some leads," Westrick said early Sunday before revealing an arrest. "The suspect vehicles range from motorcycles to a truck with a trailer on it." Despite the shooting, Westrick sounded optimistic about rally safety. "Downtown was a safe event," he said. "This did not occur downtown." Westrick initially held off on commenting about the security risks involved with such an event. He was uncertain in the immediate aftermath of the incident about the location or number of gunshot wounds. "I wouldn't want to even discuss that at this time," he said, "the reason being that we're so early on in the investigation." The Hollister Rally is in its 2nd year of a revival after a 5-year hiatus due to concerns about once-escalating security costs, which have been reduced significantly in the past 2 years. There were other violent crimes over the weekend, but Westrick said police would wait to provide information on those arrests & other incidents.

3 Boozefighter bikers shot after rally; clashed with Wino's – July 7, 2014 – *Hollister, California* – By <http://www.ksbw.com> - Three members of the Boozefighters motorcycle club were shot during a clash with rival Wino's Crew bikers who attended the 2014 Hollister Motorcycle Rally. The triple shooting happened July 6 at 10:30 a.m. at a gas station at 631 San Felipe Road when Boozefighters fought with Wino's Crew members, Hollister Police Chief David Westrick said. On Monday, the victims were recovering at a Bay Area trauma center. So far, they have refused to cooperate with detectives, Westrick said. Investigators believe Michael Richard Kich, 42, of Reno, Nevada, fired the gun. He is also a Boozefighter. Kich was booked into the San Benito County Jail on suspicion of assault with a deadly weapon, & posted bail hours later. "The initial investigation & witness statements revealed the confrontation was with rival motorcycle club, Wino's Crew. Several of those involved, witnesses, & victims, are not cooperating with police in this investigation. The cause of this incident is still under investigation. However, the Wino's Crew website hints at a feud since 1996 between the Boozefighters & the Wino's Crew," Westrick said. Detectives determined violence flared between the same 2 rival groups on July 5. During the July 5 confrontation, Wino's Crew member Kelly Eugene Rivas was arrested for possessing a concealed weapon. Rivas, 51, of Grass Valley, Calif., was carrying a knife on the 500 block of San Benito Street, police said. The rally happened this year from July 4-6. Police said they arrested 28 people total & issued citations to 16.

The Hollister Shooting - July 7, 2014 – *California* – By The Aging Rebel; www.AgingRebel.com - There was a shooting in Hollister yesterday morning between members of MCs. Members of both clubs have been reluctant to share details about the shooting so, unfortunately, most info about the incident has been released by police. Most readers of this site understand that multiple police Depts including the ATF regularly read both articles & comments posted to The Aging Rebel. Television station KION has reported that 1 of the 2 clubs involved in the shooting was the Boozefighters MC.

Police Account: According to Hollister police, “2 rival MCs had a physical altercation” at the Hollister Rally site in downtown Hollister on Sat night. “One member of the involved clubs was arrested for a concealed weapons violation (possession of dirk or dagger). Both clubs left the event area shortly after this incident.” Sunday morning at approximately 11 o’clock, as 1 of the clubs was gassing up, the “same 2 clubs crossed paths at the Chevron Station” “at 631 San Felipe Rd” “and violence erupted. It appears that multiple people in both clubs were involved in an initial physical altercation which then resulted in shots being fired by 1 or more people involved in this altercation.” The police release states “All 4 victims received medical attention by Hollister Fire Dept” & a private ambulance service named American Medical Response. The police release continues, “Three of these victims were flown for medical attention to bay area hospitals. No info is available on the medical condition of these victims. It should be noted; a 4th victim refused medical attention at the crime scene. This investigation is in its preliminary stages. Investigative leads are being followed up at this time. However initially; it appears there are multiple suspects.” Hollister P.D. Chief David Westrick is quoted in the press release as saying, “Grown men shooting at each other over colors is in no way honorable or respectful to our community’s hospitality. Like I’ve said in the past, if you want to fight over colors, fight for our Nation’s red, white & blue.” 3 of the wounded were transported to “a Bay Area hospital.”

US bikies patch over NZ gang – July 7, 2014 – *New Zealand* – By www.PerthNow.com.au - Another internat’l bikie gang has moved into New Zealand, patching over a Napier gang of the same name, according to a gang expert. The Outlaws - the oldest outlaw MC in the world - made the move over the weekend, Univ of Canterbury gang researcher & lecturer Dr Jarrod Gilbert says. The local gang was established in 1968 & previously had friendly relations but no formal affiliation with its internat’l namesake, he said. The internat’l Outlaws were established in Illinois in 1935 & now have chapters around the world. Dr. Gilbert, in a blog published on Monday, said the new gang had plans to start a supporter club under the name Black & White 15, derived from its colors & the letter O being the 15th in the alphabet. Napier police were unaware of the development, a spokeswoman told AAP. Police national headquarters were unwilling to comment on Dr. Gilbert’s claims. Dr. Gilbert said the Outlaws’ move was part of a “resurgent” gang scene in New Zealand. Earlier this year, he said another internat’l bikie gang, Bandidos, had expanded from Auckland into Christchurch, by patching over the local gang Rock Machine, & gang wars were inevitable. Dr. Gilbert said with the Outlaws, Bandidos & Hells Angels, New Zealand now boasted 3 of the world’s largest bikie gangs.

Putin’s Biker Gang – July 7, 2014 – *Russia* – By Richard Parry; www.journeymen.tv - How do you make a man like Vladimir Putin jealous? Hitch a ride with his favorite motorcycle gang leader, Alexander Zaldostanov. In a rare interview, Zaldostanov discusses a unified Russia with the Ukraine. At a show in 2011,

Putin rode with the Night Wolves motorcycle gang & praised the bikers’ patriotism. It was vital, the Pres said, to help forge “one unified & indivisible Russian nation.” We are invited into their lair - a dark & sinister base on the outskirts of Moscow - to meet a Ukrainian-born man pushing for ‘one country’: “whatever others say, the Ukraine is part of the Russian world”, he claims. The Night Wolves drove through Ukraine to Sebastopol earlier this year, officially to deliver aid to pro-Russian rebels. Night Wolves leader Zaldostanov claims his dreams for his bike club are “as real now as the re-union of Russia & Crimea”.

Smelling farts is good for your health – July 11, 2014 – *United Kingdom* – By <http://theweek.com> - The next time someone at your office lets out a “silent but deadly” emission, maybe you should thank them. A new study at the Univ of Exeter suggests that exposure to hydrogen sulfide - aka what your body produces as bacteria breaks down food, causing gas - could prevent mitochondria damage. Yep, the implication is what you’re thinking: People are taking the research to mean that smelling farts could prevent disease & even cancer. The study, published in the Medicinal Chemistry Communications journal, found that hydrogen sulfide gas in rotten eggs & flatulence could be a key factor in treating diseases. “Although hydrogen sulfide gas is well known as a pungent, foul-smelling gas in rotten eggs & flatulence, it is naturally produced in the body & could in fact be a healthcare hero with significant implications for future therapies for a variety of diseases,” Dr. Mark Wood, a professor at the University of Exeter, said in a statement. While hydrogen sulfide gas is harmful in large doses, the study suggests that “a whiff here & there has the power to reduce risks of cancer, strokes, heart attacks, arthritis, & dementia by preserving mitochondria,” Time reports. Dr. Matt Whiteman, a University of Exeter professor who worked on the study, said in a statement that researchers are even replicating the natural gas in a new compound, AP39, to reap its health benefits.

Then I was Fred Johnson, MD, with VD. Then the AMA found out about the ADA taking away my DDS because of the VD, so they took away my MD leaving me as Fred Johnson with VD. Mongols biker club, accused of criminality, tries to shield its trademark - July 11, 2014 – *Washington, D.C.* - By Michael Doyle; www.Star-Telegram.com - Fed prosecutors are revving up efforts to seize the Mongols Nation MC trademark, taking with it associated patches & logos. But even before the scheduled Sept. 30 start of an unusual trial in Southern California, this ride has been far from easy. Prosecutors' initial trademark-snatching effort failed & cost the Justice Dept \$253,206 in attorney's fees. When prosecutors tried again, the motorcyclists sued Attorney General Eric Holder. Then, the club tried to get the trial judge disqualified. One attorney left; replaced by another whose past clients included the likes of the Grateful Dead. "This case is extremely unique," Los Angeles-area attorney Joseph A. Yanny said in an interview, "and it's very, very important." Yanny represents the Mongols Nation, an organization centered in Southern California with chapters in other states including Florida, Pennsylvania & Washington. The group founded in 1969 bills itself on its website as "the baddest 1 percenter motorcycle club in the world." A 1991 Calif Dept of Justice study of outlaw motorcycle gangs reported that "the outlaw motorcycle gang members coined this (1 percenter) phrase _ using it to differentiate themselves from the law-abiding social motorcycling clubs." Yanny says that's not the case at all. "It's not a gang," he said. "It's a club." Justice Dept officials call it a criminal enterprise. In a 44-page indictment last year, prosecutors said the organization has a "history of large-scale violence & riots, as a means to threaten & intimidate the victims & witnesses to their crimes." It's not often that an organization is criminally indicted. It's even more rare for the Gov't to try to seize a trademark through the tool of asset forfeiture. Typically, seized assets are ill-gotten gains from drug trafficking, financial fraud & other criminal activities. While trademarks may seem different, they, too, are property. "The property we seek to forfeit is intellectual property, the trademarks, but that property was used in direct relation to a wide range of illegal activity," said Thom Mrozek, spokesman for the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Central District of California. "If we prevail in the current case, no member of the gang would be allowed to wear the trademark that we believe is synonymous with the group." Asst U.S. Atty Steven Welk, head of the Central District of Calif's asset forfeiture branch, is leading the prosecution. The trademarked Mongols Nation logo now being targeted shows a ponytailed man riding a chopper. Prosecutors first sought the Mongols' trademark in Oct 2008, when 79 individual club members were indicted following an extended undercover operation. Most, if not all, pleaded guilty to assorted criminal charges. A judge, though, ultimately said the accompanying trademark forfeiture effort violated the free-speech rights of unindicted club members who wanted to wear their club patches. The Consumer Law Group of California & the American Civil Liberties Union of San Diego & Imperial Counties subsequently received attorney's fees for their successful challenge to the trademark seizure. "The Gov't never had any reasonable basis to pursue forfeiture of the (trademarks), much less defend this abuse of its forfeiture powers," U.S. District Judge David O. Carter said in his 2012 decision awarding attorneys fees. Prosecutors followed up by indicting the organization. The indictment declared, among other allegations, that "the Mongols Gang actively engaged in drug trafficking, especially the distribution of methamphetamine & cocaine," as well as "acts of violence, ranging from battery to murder." Yanny countered that any criminal acts were committed by "rogue actors" who have since departed the organization. "Most of the guys," he said, are now "clean & sober." The subsequent pretrial maneuvering has taken some sharp turns, including the Mongols' unsuccessful effort to disqualify U.S. District Judge Otis Wright

II. A former Los Angeles County deputy sheriff, Wright was appointed to the Fed bench by Pres George W. Bush. MC members believe he's biased against them, citing episodes including the judge's 2011 statement that he was "regrettably" vacating a preliminary asset forfeiture decision. "This is a criminal enterprise, as evidenced by the admission of same by no fewer than 40 people who appeared before me," Wright said at an Oct 2013 hearing, a transcript shows. "This is a dangerous enterprise." Last Feb, one of Wright's Central District of Calif judicial colleagues rejected the club's effort to disqualify him. The Mongols similarly failed in their lawsuit against Holder, in which they claimed the asset forfeiture would "unconstitutionally infringe on the club's First Amendment rights." Four months after the suit was filed, Wright dismissed it. "They are operating under the banner of the Mongols," Wright said at the Oct 2013 hearing. "It is that name that reputation, that intimidation factor which enables them to do what they do, isn't it?"

Mongols visit ups Palm Springs police staffing – July 11, 2014 – *California* – By Reza Gostar; www.DesertSun.com - Police are increasing staffing this weekend in preparation for a motorcycle club gathering at the Hilton Palm Springs on East Tahquitz Canyon Way. The Mongols are expected to stay in the area from Friday to Sunday. "We have increased our staffing & are utilizing support from Riverside County gang task force units," said Palm Springs police Lt. Mike Kovaleff. "We utilize county resources when we have these types of groups in town." Since Friday morning, police have made three weapons arrests in connection to the club's visit, Kovaleff said. Two were for firearms-related charges & one was for a bladed weapon. Police are not anticipating any major incidents once the club members all check in at the hotel, Kovaleff added. There are various Mongol chapter members in town, he said. One of the concerns is the possibility of violence stemming from encounters with other MC s, such as the Hells Angels or Vagos, according to police.

Bike Night Shut Down Makes a Comeback – July 11, 2014 – *Arkansas* – By Amy Irene White, Wicked Bitch; <http://amyirenewhite.wordpress.com> - There has been a recent bout of various Gov'ts & law enforcement shutting down bike nights using zoning laws as the reason. Arkansas is not an exception. A-State Boys MC, a sport club that is ran by strict protocol & intermingles heavily with the heavy in our state had this happen to them. We have many different bike nights in Central Arkansas but 501 is by far the best one around. A-State State Pres Travis Lemmons is a consummate entertainer & event planner, & when combined with DJ Petey, they ensure a fantastic time at every event. The entertainment is never raunchy or rowdy beyond a bikini bike wash or a rap song. I have seen everyone from Bandidos to Boozefighters to CMAAs at their events. The activities they host include things like tough man contests doing pushups, cold water challenges, a Jackyl concert, a wrestling match.. Their bike night was held on Thu Nights at Twin Peaks bar & restaurant, a huge 2 story Hooters type establishment with rustic lumberjack decor. I never witnessed anyone popping wheelies or doing burnouts or any other erratic or dangerous behavior there. In April, a devastating tornado wiped out a large portion of central Arkansas & I had the privilege of working with A-State & the 501 bike night gathering relief for the victims of the storm. We had an unprecedented turn out & filled our trailers & had to send out for more. While we were moving bikes & trailers around trying to gather all the stuff we collected, there were vice cops milling through the crowds. We were even on Channel 11 News taking help to Mayflower... While the cops were picking on us we were doing this:

Little Rock, Ark. KTHV - Arkansans are doing everything they can to help disaster victims regroup after the storm. At the Verizon Arena, the motorcycle community gathered to drop off donation items & stuff a tractor-trailer full of supplies. Once they got the truck loaded, the bikers gave it a free escort to the damage sites. "As a motorcycle community whether you're with a club or not, it's ingrained in us to support our state, & anytime Arkansas goes through a tragedy like this, the motorcycle community is going to come together to support it," said one of the club leaders. Different motorcycle groups had drop-boxes set up across the state. As an incentive to donate, a local tattoo shop gave out free Arkansas tattoos to anyone who dropped something off.

That night they wrote tickets to Twin Peaks bar for the bikes being parked in the wrong place & the city of Little Rock completely shut down bike night using zoning laws... Or at least they tried to. We are Arkansans, we don't give up easily. Our tried & true bike shop & home of the Abate District 1 Toy Run & the legendary ride to Toy Hill, Rodney's Cycle House has once again stood & delivered. Proprietor & long time Hamster Rodney Roberts has recently opened a new fabulous location.. It includes a huge store, the Handle Bar bar & grill, & of course his bike shop... He was hosting a bike night on Thursdays as well. We all know bikers don't leave other bikers behind.. A-State & Rodney joined forces & now we have a super badass bike night of epic proportions. I don't really think you can zone bikers out of a bike shop either. Congratulations, Arkansas bikers, for your continued teamwork, unity, & tenacity. I am proud to be one of you.

Fear at center of grisly murder case Barry Porterfield – July 11, 2014 – *Oklahoma* – By Barry Porterfield; www.PaulsValleyDailyDemocrate.com - Fear is what an Elmore City man said drove him to shoot a man before dismembering his dead body & concealing the pieces in a farm pond nearly 2 years ago. Calm & steady with some strong language mixed in was Justin Hammer's testimony to jurors as he took the stand Wed to testify in his own 1st-degree murder trial. Now in the 2nd week of his trial, Hammer told the 8-man, 4-woman jury he was scared & afraid of Brandon Duran when he shot him inside of Hammer's residence near Elmore City. Hammer, 32, did not hesitate to admit to being the one who killed & dismembered Duran back on Aug. 7, 2012. "Yes I did," Hammer said when asked if he was the one who shot Duran, cut up the dead man's body & place the parts in 6 containers which he then sunk in a pond on Hammer's property. "I was at my house, by myself, in the evening when he showed up," Hammer said from the witness stand. He described having loud music playing & not hearing Duran come into the house. "When I stepped into the living room from the kitchen he was standing there. I asked what the f**k are you doing in my house. I told him to get out of my f*****g house," he said. "He said to me, 'I want to tell you to stay away from Amber, we're getting back together.'" The reference is to Amber Andrews, who is Duran's former wife & girlfriend of Hammer at the time of the deadly incident. "I grabbed my shotgun & pistol off the top of my safe," Hammer said. "He was standing there & I came toward him from the right side. I pointed it at his face & shot him," he said about the shotgun being held in his right hand. "I shot him. When he hit the ground I shot him again. I didn't hesitate. I was standing practically on top of him when I shot him again." The weapons were described as a .410 youth shotgun & a .22 caliber handgun, which Hammer said was held in his left hand & fired at just about the same time. Previous testimony has shown Duran sustained one shotgun blast to the face but likely died from the three shots fired into his head with the handgun. Both weapons were later found inside the safe as the handgun still had blood on the handle. After the shots Hammer claimed he was in shock &

unsure of what to do next. He claims to have thought about calling L.E. but instead decided to dispose of the body & try to conceal Duran's death. The defendant claims fear is what motivated his decision to place Duran's body in a large bag, drag it into his bathroom, use a saw to cut it in several pieces, 25 in all, & dispose of the parts in a nearby pond. The fear, Hammer said, was from any potential reprisals by Duran's friends, namely a biker club in Calif named the Bandidos. Hammer told jurors Duran used the Bandidos name to threaten him moments before the fatal shooting. "He said he could have my whole family killed," Hammer said. "I was in fear of retaliation from his friends in the Bandidos. All I was ever told was he was a 1 percenter in the Bandidos," he said, adding that was a higher level member. "I associated them with the Hells Angels." The defendant, who described cutting up the various parts of Duran's body, then denied buying various items in advance as part of a plan to conceal the death. The items, including 5 plastic buckets & lids & ready mix concrete, were purchased by Hammer at a Pauls Valley hardware store days before the shooting. Hammer used his own store rewards card to make the purchases. Instead, Hammer claims the buckets were to transport water for the pit bull dogs he was raising on his property, while the concrete was make some repairs to the corner of a dog kennel. Hammer did admit to later lying to authorities because "I knew I had done something wrong. I was in a bad situation. I was scared. I was scared of going to jail. I had a fear of who Brandon was involved with."

Thomas White Is Still Free - July 14, 2014 – *Ohio* – By The Aging Rebel; www.AgingRebel.com - "Justice delayed," the 19th Century British Prime Minister William Gladstone once remarked, "is justice denied." Most people interpret Gladstone's remark to mean that he thought justice is a good thing. Meanwhile, in the new & improved America, a 30-year old named Michael McCloskey, whose friends used to call him "Biker Mike," remains confined to a wheelchair & Thomas Caine White, the 32-year-old, former, part-time Ottawa Hills, Ohio cop who gunned McCloskey down like a mad dog during a routine traffic stop on May 23, 2009 is still free to jog, shop at Walmart & get drunk at his 4th of July barbecue.

The Crime: McCloskey, who was then 25 & a friend named Aaron Snyder were riding their H-D motorcycles in Ottawa Hills, near Toledo, about 2:15 a.m. White initially said he signaled the pair to stop for exceeding the 25-miles-per hour speed limit but would later say he believed the men were alcohol impaired. White called for backup & a second Ottawa Hills cop named Christopher Sargent observed Snyder drive over a curb into grass & then back onto the street before stopping. Sargent took Snyder into custody on suspicion of drunk driving. After McCloskey came to a stop White pulled up behind him. While White was still in the cruiser with his lights & sirens on, McCloskey looked over his right shoulder toward White's vehicle & then looked toward the backup officer arresting the other rider. White got out of the cruiser & yelled something & when McCloskey turned again to glance over his right shoulder McCloskey shot him in the back. The entire traffic stop was recorded on a video camera in McCloskey's cruiser & you can watch that raw video below. McCloskey was instantly paralyzed from the waist down although he retained feeling in his lower extremities. His motorcycle fell on him exhaust side down & as his hot exhaust pipes burned through his leg McCloskey begged White & Sargent to pull the bike off him. After Snyder ran to help McCloskey he asked White & Sargent to help him get the 600 pound motorcycle off the 200 pound man. White replied, "He's your friend. You get the bike off of him." McCloskey's burns caused nerve damage & he remains in constant pain.

The Defense: White was eventually charged with felonious assault with a firearm enhancement. He went to trial & his defense consisted of trying to convince jurors not to believe their own eyes. White testified at his trial a year after the shooting that he had ordered McCloskey to put his hands up & that McCloskey had made “a reaching movement” the led White to believe McCloskey was pulling a weapon. The professional police establishment rallied to White’s defense. Several “expert” witnesses testified McCloskey was to blame for getting in the way of White’s bullet. A former FBI Agent named Urey Patrick testified “If McCloskey had turned off the bike & raised his hands on the handle bars this wouldn’t have happened.”

The Appeals: White was convicted & the month after his trial he was sentenced to ten years in prison. After his conviction, the former cop was allowed to remain free on \$100,000 bond while he pursued his appeals. White’s conviction was overturned by the Ohio 6th District Court of Appeals in Jan 2013. White’s lawyers argued that the former cop was a public employee who had acted in good faith. The Appeals Court ruled that the firearm enhancement that guaranteed White would have to serve at least 3 years in prison could not be applied to cops, & ordered prosecutors to retry White without that enhancement. Prosecutors appealed that ruling to the Ohio Supreme Court which heard oral arguments on the case in early February. Both the Fraternal Order of Police of Ohio, Inc. & The National Fraternal Order of Police filed amici curiae briefs on White’s behalf. In oral argument Christina Corl, the attorney representing The Nat’l Fraternal Order of Police, told the court “You have to understand that a police officer acting & discharging his service weapon in the line of duty is just fundamentally different from the armed robber holding up a gas station.” In other words, the law applies differently to cops. As of this morning, the Supreme Court of Ohio had not issued a ruling & White remains free.

Attacks from outside & inside – July 14, 2014 – Germany – By Von Kuno Kruse; www.Stern.de - The insignia of the Hells Angels will be banned. Reason enough for a crisis call in a big way. The proportion of club members who earn their money in the red light, is well below ten percent. And also there operate only a few brothels. Many slide as economists guard, if the suitors make the rooms trouble.

Clubs grown too fast: In consequence of the so-called rocker war against the Bandidos, which is evident in many discussions, the rockers are in agreement not only within their brotherhood, but also with the Bandidos fact that the clubs have grown too fast. The long phase of testing, the years of hard slog of so-called Hang Around Prospect, as the candidates are called to a club membership, to full member, had been criminally abbreviated in some clubs to quickly collect clout of the road. It would not Turks, Arabs or German, we are not really that Hells Angels had built up a position in the environment, says Lutz Schelhorn in whose club migrant children from 5 countries are, but not one is from the red light. It also was not a question that people would come from the milieu of the Hells Angels. This is about those who believed they could use the patch to there or anywhere else to make money.

Second Hollister Shooting Arrest - July 16, 2014 – California –

The shooting resulted from a confrontation between members of the Boozefighters MC & members of the Wino’s Crew MC. Three Boozefighters were shot during the incident. A 4th Boozefighter named Michael Kich, was arrested on suspicion of assault with a deadly weapon & posted bail. Kich & the 3 injured Boozefighters are all from NV.

Lamar Guy Jones Copeland: According to a Hollister Police press release, “The investigation has led officers to identify the alleged shooter of the “Boozefighters” as Wino’s Crew member, Lamar Guy Jones Copeland (photo above), 27, of Sacramento. A warrant for his arrest was issued several days ago & police have been working with the Sacramento P.D. in an attempt to locate him. After many hours of investigation & surveillance, the Sacramento Police Criminal Intelligence Unit located Copeland in Sacramento” yesterday. Yesterday morning, “Hollister Detectives drove to the Sacramento area to take custody of Copeland. He was transported back to Hollister & booked at the San Benito County Jail for attempted murder, assault with a deadly weapon & felon in possession of a firearm. He is being held with no bail.”

Bad Blood: Hollister police have already said the shooting was a continuation of a dispute that began outside Johnny’s Bar & Grill in Hollister on the evening of July 5. During that incident police arrested Wino’s Crew patch holder Kelly Rivas of Grass Valley, Calif for carrying a concealed knife. Police have said that fight was recorded by the newly installed video surveillance apparatus in downtown Hollister. No members of the Boozefighters MC are believed to be cooperating with the police investigation. Wino’s Crew is an offshoot of the Boozefighters & it is named in honor of Boozefighters founder William “Wino Willie” Forkner who died in June 1997. Wino’s Crew was formed 3 months before Forkner’s death. Wino’s Crew states, “We are a brotherhood formed around the traditions & memory of Wino Willie Forkner, founder of the Boozefighters MC. We are not a part of the BFMC nor are we a farm club. We were organized to defend Wino Willie, ‘JD’ John & the rest of the original Boozefighters from being dumped on by the new breed of Boozefighters in Texas.”

Lawmakers urged to get ahead of proliferation of outlaw motorcycle gangs – July 16, 2014 – *Utah* – By Marjorie Cortez; www.DeseretNews.com - This is the place - or more so becoming the place - for outlaw motorcycle gangs, a veteran police officer told state lawmakers Wed. "There's been a 300% increase in the members of outlaw motorcycle gangs in Utah, compared to what we experienced 5 years ago," Utah County Sheriff's Sgt. Lane Critser told members of the Legislature's L.E. & Criminal Justice Interim Committee. Critser, who has worked in gang enforcement since 2008, said the proliferation of gangs & gang members could be attributed to multiple factors. Utah is an "untouched" state, meaning no gang has claimed territory as its own. Also, law enforcement in Utah is unaccustomed to dealing with outlaw motorcycle gangs on a regular basis, he said. "It's like a gold rush. Everybody is trying to get here & establish dominance in the state so they can run a variety of their criminal activities & make their money in the state," Critser said. The trend is disturbing, he said, because many long-established outlaw motorcycle gangs have ties to Mexican drug cartels, according to U.S. Dept of Justice reports. They also commit insurance fraud & forgery to support their activities, Critser said. The state also is becoming increasingly attractive to members of outlaw motorcycle clubs because Utah is largely rural, said Rep. Paul Ray, R-Clearfield. "A lot of our counties don't have the manpower or the money to fight them or handle them when they come into town on a run," Ray said. A number of gangs have conducted national runs in rural Utah, Critser said. In 2008, the Bandidos hosted a national mandatory run in Moab. The Mongols have conducted a run in Wayne County in the past 5 years. Two summers ago, the Vagos made a run into Ogden, Ray said. However, several members racked up citations for multiple violations in numerous counties while en route to Weber County. "By the time they got there, they just turned around & went home. They didn't want to deal with it anymore," Ray said. "Really, you've got to make it expensive & uncomfortable for these guys & they won't want to stick around." Recently, the Barons, a motorcycle gang with a longtime presence in Utah, hosted members of the Gypsy Jokers gang during the Barons' annual summer run to Wasatch County. A small group of Gypsy Jokers gang members entered the Rainbow Family gathering outside of Heber City, & an altercation took place. Critser said it was unclear who was the aggressor, but the gang members were arrested on charges of DUI, drug offenses & possession of deadly weapons. Weaponry seized during arrests of outlaw gang members across the country suggest that some have law-enforcement or military-grade firearms & body armor, Critser said. A zero tolerance policy in Ventura County, Calif, helped curb the activities of Hells Angels, he said, meaning every crime, violation or offense was enforced to the fullest extent, whether it was a new crime or a probation violation. "Basically it got to the point that members of Hells Angels said we don't want to be gang members in Ventura County anymore & they left. When they were interviewed, they basically said it got too expensive & it got difficult going to jail every time after committing a crime because they were being watched & there's a system to take care of it," Critser said. While he offered no details, Ray said he intends to introduce a gang initiative during the 2015 legislative session. Rep. Curtis Oda, R-Clearfield, said state lawmakers may want to revisit the gang injunction used by Weber County until it was thrown out of court. The Utah Supreme Court threw out the injunction ruling that the county did not properly serve summons to gang members. "This is the same law that Calif had for nearly two decades, & their Supreme Court said it was fine. And our Supreme Court says we have a problem with this? It was starting to work," Oda said. He said the state should retool the injunction addressing the court's

concerns, then attempt to apply it statewide. Ray said he believes the state is at a critical juncture in addressing the activities of outlaw motorcycle gangs. "We're at the point in Utah, if we take some decisive action, we can actually control the gang issue. We've got 2 choices: We can let it happen & then we have to manage it, or we can step out in front of it & control it," Ray said. "I think we're still at the point, if we get into action & work this, we can actually control it," he said.

Fed magistrate wants drug case dismissed, cites outrageous Gov't conduct – July 16, 2014 – *Nevada* – By Jeff German; www.ReviewJournal.com - A federal magistrate has recommended dismissal of felony drug trafficking charges against a former officer of the Vagos motorcycle gang because of outrageous government conduct by the lead undercover agent in the case. In a rare decision late Tue, U.S. Magistrate Judge Cam Ferenbach criticized Agostino Brancato, a deputized agent with the ATF, for manufacturing the cocaine case against Jeremy Halgat, though Halgat had no criminal record & repeatedly told the agent in secretly recorded conversations that he did not want to traffic in drugs. "The problem is that the Gov't's investigation deployed techniques that generated a wholly new crime for the sake of pressing criminal charges against Halgat," Ferenbach wrote in his 34-page decision. Ferenbach also said that despite Brancato's denial, "there is no doubt" he "falsified" a report of one of the alleged drug transactions & that supervisors of his ATF-led task force "did not dissuade him" from doing it. "This is distressing," Ferenbach said. "Can the court rely on the chain of custody of evidence that the Gov't will proffer against Halgat at trial? Did Brancato's supervisors permit other falsifications?" The Gov't had turned over a recording to the defense of Brancato allegedly talking to a task force supervisor about lying on the report to "avoid muddying up the waters," Ferenbach explained. "Brancato said 'f--- it to the formalities. They don't need to know,'" the magistrate added. The comments were part of a recording Brancato made to document the earlier drug transaction. Fed prosecutors, who in lengthy court papers denied there was wrongdoing in the investigation of Halgat, declined comment on Ferenbach's recommendation. Natalie Collins, a spokeswoman for the Nevada U.S. Atty's office, said prosecutors plan to file an opposition to the recommendation with a federal judge in a bid to keep the case alive. Brancato was the lead undercover agent in "Operation Pure Luck," a three-year joint investigation led by the ATF into drug & illegal weapons dealing by members of motorcycle gangs, including the Vagos. Las Vegas police, North Las Vegas police & the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Dept were part of the task force. The investigation launched in April 2010 with the secret help of a Vagos gang member, & 2 years later Brancato, a Los Angeles County sheriff's deputy deputized by the ATF, became a full-fledged member of the Vagos club while working undercover. Brancato's status with the L.A. County Sheriff's Dept was not available late Wed, according to Dept spokeswoman Nicole Nishida. More than 2 dozen motorcycle gang members were charged with drug & weapons trafficking in a series of federal & state indictments last year in the high-profile investigation. Halgat, 36, a former Vagos sergeant at arms who goes by the nickname "Maniak," is charged in two cases. He faces a separate drug conspiracy indictment stemming from a March 2013 sting at a Searchlight airstrip set up by undercover agents posing as Mexican drug cartel members flying cocaine to Las Vegas. Halgat's co-defendant in the case before Ferenbach has pleaded guilty & is waiting to be sentenced. The magistrate's stinging recommendation against the Gov't was a response to court papers filed by Halgat's defense lawyer, Melanie Hill. "The Gov't is not allowed to manufacture crimes solely to prosecute a

citizen,” said Hill, who has filed a similar motion in Halgat’s other case, which is before a different magistrate & judge. Hill suggested Ferenbach’s decision will impact Brancato’s credibility as a witness & may jeopardize other prosecutions stemming from the investigation in federal & state court. In his decision, Ferenbach said Halgat “was not eager to participate in Brancato’s scheme in any capacity.” Halgat, he explained, had used cocaine & dealt drugs in the past but had “repudiated” those activities. “His willingness to traffic in drugs only re-emerged after ATF injected itself into Halgat’s life & repeatedly solicited his services,” Ferenbach wrote. Brancato also was unable to get Halgat to sell him illegal firearms, according to the magistrate. Ferenbach said he was troubled that the “ATF had investigated Halgat for three years, found no contraband after executing two search warrants & indicted him for a crime designed & initiated by the ATF.” He said he agreed with a similar Fed case decision that suggested the “government engages in outrageous conduct when it engineers & directs the crime from start to finish.” Another decision, Ferenbach said, concluded: “The function of law enforcement is the prevention of crime & the apprehension of criminals. Manifestly, that function does not include the manufacturing of crime.”

Sky Is Falling On ATF - July 17, 2014- *Nevada* - By The Aging Rebel; www.AgingRebel.com - Operation Pure Luck, announced on June 27, 2013, was never anything other than a public relations opportunity for a handful of unscrupulous bureaucrats to brag about how they had taken on the outlaw biker menace in Las Vegas & triumphed. The chicken hawks at the news conference were U.S. Atty for the District of Nevada Daniel Bogden, Clark County District Atty Steve Wolfson & Joseph Riehl who is the Special Agent in Charge of the ATF field office in San Francisco. All 3 of them should probably be stripped & hung in steel cages suspended an easy stone’s throw over the Vegas Strip. Responsible news outlets put on their miniskirts & strolled for Pure Luck. KSNV in Vegas used the headline tease, “Fed, state & local L.E. indict more than 30 bikers in a sting they say targeted some of the most violent motorcycle gang members in the nation.” Then after calling Bogden, Wolfson, Riehl & a handful of local cops Daddy, KSNV stopped covering the case. Nobody covered the case because there never really was a case & great pains were taken to conceal what there was. Pure Luck might have been just the one public relations opportunity but it became a score of overlapping Fed & state criminal cases & this week it all began to fall apart.

Agostino Brancato: All there ever was, was a 4-year-long undercover investigation that never really went anywhere because the principal undercover investigator, a Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Deputy named Agostino Brancato, who moonlights as a Tactical Field Officer for the ATF, could never really convince the Vagos, Mongols, Bandidos & others he met to actually commit crimes much more serious than speeding. So Brancato made stuff up. The ATF always makes stuff up. ATF undercovers act out preplanned dramas for video cameras. The dramas are carefully contrived to portray the Bureau’s chosen victims in the worst possible light. The Bureau, in cooperation with the oxymoronic Dept of Justice, alters & hides evidence in order to convict innocent, or almost innocent, men. The ATF Reports of Investigation are the worst. They are frequently, literally, manufactured evidence.

Sadistic State: Virtually all recent ATF entrapments of motorcycle club members & virtually all the subsequent prosecutions epitomize what Andrew Carlon, writing in the

Virginia Law Review, called the “sadistic state.” Carlon describes an investigative & legal process that has “short circuited...a state run amok. It is a state that has decided that, since its unique function is the power to punish, it must pursue punishment as an intrinsic good, independent of desert (or, indeed, of the other, more consequentialist aims of punishment), transforming itself into a ‘punishment machine.’ But as we have seen, punishment without desert reduces to sadism. We get the ‘sadistic state,’ which wields power, most fully realized through the infliction of pain, as an end in itself, the human beings in its power merely means to that awful end.” “The sadistic state raises the specter of totalitarianism. As Professor Hannah Arendt writes, the totalitarian criminal justice system is marked by, among other things, the ‘replacement of the suspected offense by the possible crime.’” Operation Pure Luck should become a case study for political science students interested in a state run amok. Bogden, Wolfson, Riehl & their fellow villains knew the case was dirty & mostly baseless from the start. That’s partly why the case was divided into many parts – to frustrate public scrutiny of what was really going on. Pure Luck was eerily similar to the equally dirty Operation Black Rain that culminated in the arrest of seventy-nine Mongols & the persecution by civil forfeiture of hundreds more.

Déjà Vu All Over Again: TFO Tino Brancato has a history. He was a bad actor in Black Rain in Vegas. His accomplices were a professional criminal & snitch who was born Steve Veltus but who was most recently rechristened Steven Maschari by the United States Marshals’ Witness Protection Program. Veltus/Maschari is still breaking the same laws other men are sent to prison for breaking & still defrauding people. He escaped justice & 2 law suits late last year in Wisconsin when the DOJ convinced a local judge that it was vital to law & order that Veltus not be punished for his crimes. Brancato’s mentor in that investigation was a despicable ATF agent named John Carr who was also Veltus’ handler and, according to William Queen, was an OG in John Ciccone’s original anti-biker “gang.” Carr, who specializes in drug entrapments & who has won numerous awards for that, including a Fed Bar Association Medal of Valor Award, was recently rebuked by idiosyncratic Fed District Judge Manuel L. Real for an entrapment Carr created out of thin air.

“The Gov’t created the fictitious crime from whole cloth,” Real wrote. “Agent Carr was the only integral part of the conspiracy to rob his fictitious stash house from the beginning. Agent Carr invented the amount of cocaine present, making his planned robbery worth approximately \$600,000. He invented the 2 old men guarding the fictitious stash house, that they were armed, & thus the need for the defendants to bring guns. Although Agent Carr may never have said the phrase ‘make sure you bring guns,’ he told the defendants that the 2 men guarding the stash house were armed & that he could not get the guns. When the defendants brought guns to the warehouse, they merely did so as part of Agent Carr’s plan. Agent Carr was to provide the getaway car & be at the fictitious stash house to let his coconspirators through the door. Despite the Gov’t’s argument that the defendants planned the crime, Agent Carr controlled all the details, communicating that the defendants would need to bring guns, detailing how they would enter the fictitious stash house, & how they would get away. Agent Carr insisted that he would be at the fictitious stash house during the robbery & that he would open the door for the defendants. When Agent Carr said he wanted to meet everyone at the warehouse to plan the robbery, Roberts said that there was no need & he would just show the others Agent Carr’s photograph, but Agent Carr insisted that he meet everyone to go exactly over the plan. Once at the warehouse, Agent Carr insisted

on running through a script to ensure there was a conspiracy. Moreover, none of the defendants even knew of the location of the fictitious stash house. Without Agent Carr there could have been no agreement at all. The Gov't's crime is a lie & a falsehood. Agent Carr was lying to the defendants the whole time. Everything Agent Carr said was part of his fraud on the defendants. If Agent Carr was not acting on behalf of the Gov't, he could be charged for fraud for his scheme. Agent Carr for all purposes planned the robbery & the conspiracy from beginning to end. The Gov't argues he did not tell the defendants how to do their part, but their part was only agreeing to go along with Agent Carr. Agent Carr told them the details of the targeted fictitious stash house, that he would let them in, provide the vehicle, & told them of the obstacles they would encounter. The only thing Agent Carr did not provide them with was guns. However, Agent Carr & the ATF needed to have the arrests for guns, & it was not the defendants who asked about the need of guns. But the crime that the defendants were indicted for was conspiracy, which Agent Carr was most definitively an active conspirator, the ring leader, & orchestrator of the whole agreement. But despite Agent Carr's integral part as the mastermind of the conspiracy who was in charge of all the details, the Gov't did not indict him. Agent Carr encouraged all the defendants to agree to his fictitious plot; at the warehouse, Agent Carr's carefully orchestrated script ensured he would get the defendants to agree. Thus the Gov't's role in creating, encouraging, & participating in this conspiracy was pervasive from beginning to end. Moreover, had the defendants actually robbed a real stash house, regardless of their aspirations, & there was only one kilogram of cocaine at the real stash house, they could only be charged with possession of that one kilogram of cocaine. That Agent Carr was able to lie about all the details of the crime – the 20–25 kilograms of cocaine, the necessity to bring guns – then use those fictitious details so that the Gov't can indict the defendants for a crime with a much greater mandatory minimum sentence, is outrageous. It would be unconscionable for this court to condone & sanction the Gov't's fraud in this case."

Melanie A. Hill: These sorts of entrapments are rarely exposed or even opposed by defense lawyers. As a rule, defense lawyers get paid to encourage their clients to plead guilty. Following Operation Black Rain, for example, one public defender told his provably innocent client, "Look. You're in the Mongols motorcycle gang. What do you expect?" The difference between Operation Black Rain & Operation Pure Luck was that one of the defendants was Jeremy "Maniak" Halgat & his lawyer was Melanie A. Hill. Hill has actually spent the last 13 months trying to prove Halgat innocent instead of trying to convince him to take the deal. Halgat was a target because he was the Vagos Motorcycle Club's Vegas Valley Vice President & the club's Southern Nevada Regional Sergeant at Arms. Brancato patched into the Vagos, did his thing, & Halgat was subsequently indicted in two, separate Fed cases called USA v. Halgat et al, & USA v. Wickham et al. Both cases allege basically the same things & both are built on Brancato's accusations.

ATF SOP: Two years into Operation Pure Luck Brancato became the "Vagos Clark County Sergeant at Arms & initiated a series illegal drug & guns sales" including an alleged purchase of anabolic steroids. Despite numerous enticements, Halgat refused to deal drugs with Brancato. Brancato went to extraordinary ends to entice Halgat to do something illegal, even offering to tip Halgat \$50 for introducing Brancato to a Mongols Motorcycle Club hang around who apparently did sell Brancato drugs. Halgat refused the \$50, telling his club brother, "Don't worry about it, you paid for my dinner & you can just get me on the back end."

Later that evening, Brancato discussed with his ATF supervisors how he could implicate Halgat by lying. "You know what," Brancato thought out loud. "I may do this is what I'm thinking. Like as far as I'm concerned fucking Maniak sold me this fucking ounce, bro. I mean, really. Yeah. Well, that's what I'm thinking. Well, this is what I'm thinking, bro is that on the QP, we do it the same way. Let Maniak...I give Maniac the money, he goes in there, brings it back to me, da, da, da. And then on the next one, I'm like hey, bro, can I just go to him direct & I'll still give you the money & now I have a sale of QP with him. You know what I'm saying? With Udell, without him, so now, he owns one & then this guy & Maniak owns one. Well, alright, so we may need a little bit more. We maybe have to do a little bit more. That's...which is perfect. Yup." During the same recorded telephone conversation "stated that he would fabricate the portion of his Report of Investigation regarding the operation's debriefing: Alright, bro. I'm just putting it in the mailbox right now. All right, & then there's \$300 & everything else in there.... Bro, I'm just going to say I'm not going to tell them how. I just did it like last time. I just transferred, yeah. I'm not going to put the whole mailbox thing bro. Fuck it. They don't need to (know), I mean that's irrelevant. I just gained...I met you at a disclosed fucking location & gave you the evidence during the debriefing. Fuck it. Just that would muddy the waters up so."

Dismissal: Because Brancato's entrapments were so undeniably corrupt, Tue a Fed Magistrate Judge named Cam Ferenbach dismissed the indictment against Halgat in USA v. Wickham et al. Hill has also moved for a dismissal of USA v. Halgat. In that motion she wrote: "The Gov't's conduct in this case & Mr. Halgat's related case was so outrageous that the indictment against Mr. Halgat must be dismissed. Rather than infiltrating an existing drug conspiracy or criminal organization engaged in ongoing criminal activity, the Gov't created, invented, & imagined up crimes for the defendants to be induced & entrapped into committing for the purpose of charging members of the Vagos MC with drug & gun crimes. The Gov't agents, Task Force Officers, & undercover ATF deputized TFO Agostino Brancato induced the defendants to participate in a fictitious crime involving drugs provided by the Gov't flown to an airstrip, arranged by the Gov't, in a Cessna airplane arranged for & flown by the Gov't, when the defendants were not suspected (or even identified) of being involved in conspiring to distribute drugs & then recorded themselves discussing falsifying a Report of Investigation & thereafter falsified a ROI & property report. The same undercover agent, TFO Brancato, that recorded himself discussing what actually occurred during a recorded transaction & what he would say occurred, is the same UC that 'engineered & directed the criminal enterprise from start to finish' in this case with the assistance of ATF agents, TFOs, & other Gov't agents."

"Over the last 40 years, courts have discussed outrageous Gov't conduct in numerous contexts, but this theme runs through all outrageous Gov't conduct cases determining what law enforcement conduct also becomes constitutionally unacceptable: The Gov't cannot engineer & direct a criminal scheme from start to finish or create a new crime merely for the sake of prosecuting a defendant."

Games Prosecutors Play: A little further into the motion, Hill describes the games Fed prosecutors play. "The Gov't chose to indict Mr. Halgat in 2 separate indictments. The Gov't did not set up Halgat or charge Halgat in 2 separate cases by happenstance. It was a concerted & calculated effort to attempt to charge Halgat with a small conspiracy to distribute cocaine case in an attempt to

argue that he was predisposed to distribute cocaine to allow the Gov't to attempt to argue that Halgat (who had no criminal record whatsoever) is unable to assert an entrapment defense as a matter of law. It was also charged this way so that Halgat would be unable to move to sever the counts & therefore prevent the Gov't from using one case in the other & vice versa & instead move to use one case in the other by arguing that the cases are inextricably intertwined. This is exactly what the Gov't did in this case by filing a motion in limine to preclude Halgat & his co-defendants from asserting an entrapment defense & by filing a response to Halgat's motion for 404(b) notice arguing that the cases are inextricably intertwined. The motion in limine was denied without prejudice to allow the Gov't to raise the motion again during trial. These tactics are routinely used in reverse sting operations to prevent an entrapment defense & the Court should not condone these tactics by allowing the Gov't to benefit from its strategic decision to charge the alleged drug transactions in 2 separate cases."

Fabrications: "TFO Brancato created a fictitious criminal distribution of cocaine conspiracy, planned the entire fake crime,¹⁵ & induced Mr. Halgat with pleas based on friendship & brotherhood as well as his need for money to support himself to convince Mr. Halgat to introduce him to Mr. Wickham so that he could purchase cocaine from Mr. Wickham," Hill continues. "TFO Brancato & the ATF set up this undercover reverse sting operation for the sole purpose of ensnaring the defendants & charging them with crimes to justify the ATF's infiltration of the Vagos." "Here, the crime was fabricated entirely by the ATF & TFO Brancato to secure Mr. Halgat's conviction & Mr. Halgat had no criminal behavior to protect the public from because he was not engaging in the trafficking of cocaine when the ATF infiltrated the Vagos until the ATF started to invent crimes a year & a half after the infiltration." "Mr. Halgat was under surveillance for 18 months & neither ATF nor the CI observed him committing any distribution of cocaine or gun offenses despite trying to get Mr. Halgat to engage in an illegal gun offense. Unsatisfied with this result, & to justify the large amount of money invested into the operation, TFO Brancato decided to take measures into his own hands & began soliciting Mr. Halgat to induce him to commit a crime." There is more. There is much more. Alone among defenders in these sorts of cases, Hill seems to comprehend the realities of the war on motorcycle clubs & the sort of strategies "Ciccone's gang" have been using for the last 15 years. It is debatable what impact Judge Ferenbach's ruling will have long term. Short term it looks like the long slide of the U.S.A. into a sadistic state has at least been slowed. "The ramifications for the Gov't are serious," Hill said yesterday. Anyone who cares about justice can only hope she is right.

Sonny Barger Hells Angels Anniversary Party – July 17, 2014 – *Arizona* – By www.Thunderpress.net - There really is nothing like the roar of hundreds of motorcycles rising up over the desert hills with riders united in the freedom of the ride, pushing through the warm desert air creating smiles for miles behind those bushy beards with hearts pumping & adrenaline racing. That's what comes with a pack ride with the Hell's Angels, their families, friends & supporters who have come from all over the country to celebrate the 57th Anniversary of Sonny Barger with his club, the Hells Angels. It would seem as though the anniversary party really started earlier in the week with the opening of Arizona Bike Week in the Sonoran Desert community of Cave Creek, AZ. Sonny & the Cave Creek crew were set up there with many other vendors. Cave Creek's small community population of about 5,200 would be swelling with the thousands of bikers who would visit during Arizona Bike Week. Sonny & his wife Zorana were there most of the week selling DVD's of his recent film Dead in 5 Heartbeats, T-shirts, books & other support gear. It was most notable that Sonny wasn't riding his Victory Cross Country; he was test-riding a Thunder Black 2014 Indian Chieftain while his Victory was in for some service. Sonny was loving that new Indian & his new full-face Bell helmet. The real celebration of Sonny's 57th Anniversary culminated on the final day of Arizona Bike Week with a poker run that started at the all-familiar Steel Horse Saloon in Phoenix where all the riders registered, & visited with friends new & old. Belt Drive Betty And The Iron Order - July 19, 2014 – U.S.A. / Canada – By The Aging Rebel; www.AgingRebel.com - Members & supporters of the Iron Order MC have been flaming this site for the last 2 weeks. It isn't the 1st time this has happened. The Aging Rebel's coverage of the murders of John Lindeman & Brad Lutzow in Phoenix in Feb 2009 infuriated members of the Sober Riders MC as well. Although the tenor of the Iron Order complaints this time around has made the Sober Riders look like a convention of professional diplomats. Many of the Iron Order comments have trashed Zach Tipton's memory. One particularly memorable argument was that Tipton should have brought more than his fists to a gunfight. Over & over commenters have protested this page's description of the homicide as a "murder." The Iron Order supporters have replied that Tipton was shot by the still unidentified Iron Order prospect in the side of the head in "self-defense." Multiple commenters have editorialized that the members of the American Outlaws Association will do nothing about Tipton's murder because there is nothing they can do. There have been numerous attacks on the quality of the journalism displayed here. The Iron Order as a group seems to think this page is written by an amateur ape who for some inexplicable reason has decided to attack their club.

Member Directory: All this trash talk abruptly stopped yesterday when, apparently, the Iron Order leadership became the last people in the world to know that an Iron Order "Member Directory" has been circulating for about 2 weeks. The roster lists the name, road name, chapter, address, phone number, email address & region of virtually all 3,816 Iron Order members & prospects from "Beer" Robinson to "ZZ Top" Carwhile. This page has used a copy of the directory to identify commenters. Curiously, the member directory also notices which of its members are authorized to carry a firearm. For example, Ray "Izod" Lubesky, an Internat'l Officer of the club who lives in Valrico, Florida is authorized to carry. It strikes this page that this is a curious thing for a "law abiding MC" to catalog. Especially a law abiding club that actively provokes conflicts with all the "criminal" clubs. At the least, that suggests premeditated self defense. Which tortures the concept of self defense as Bill Clinton once tortured the concept of "is."

The Iron Order Is An OMG: A lot of the Iron Order membership's ire directed at this page has swirled around this page's reporting of a fairly brief passage from an ATF report dated July 1, 2014. The lede to that story read, "Although the Iron Order MC continues to advertise itself as a 'law abiding MC' the ATF is now categorizing it as an 'outlaw motorcycle gang.'"

The exact passage quoted in the report follows: "In southern & central Maryland, the Iron Horsemen MC is furious that the Iron Order continues to don a 3-piece patch. In the past 2 months, there have been several bloody confrontations between the two. On Feb 28, 2014, both were involved in a melee at a strip club in Baltimore. Iron Horsemen members were equipped with bats, knives, MagLite flashlights & hammers. Even though nobody was killed, both OMGs suffered major injuries. One week later, as 3 Iron Order members were idling at a red light in Prince George's County, they were viciously attacked by several car loads of suspected Iron Horsemen members. 2 of the 3 Iron Order members were severely beaten with bats, ax handles & crow bars. The assailants were not wearing colors or indicia that depicted they were Iron Horsemen members, supporters or associates.

"The Iron Order is one of the fastest growing MCs in the United States. Members wear a traditional 3-piece patch with a State

bottom rocker. The fact that they wear the State bottom rocker has infuriated the HAMC, Outlaws, Iron Horsemen, Pagans & Bandidos. More importantly, many of their members are police & corrections officers, active-duty military and/or Gov't employees & contractors. "Over the past 4 years, the Iron Order has had several violent confrontations with each of the aforementioned OMGs. Per the Texas Dept of Public Safety, in 2013, an Iron Order member was run off the road by a Bandidos member. In Clarksville, Kentucky, the Iron Order & Outlaws have been involved in several violent altercations. On May 14, 2011, HAMC South Carolina Nomads member William Sosebee stabbed an Iron Order member outside a bar in South Carolina. Despite the violence, they continue to move into territory controlled by one of the Dominant Seven."

The passage was quoted accurately & the sentences that substantiate the lede are: "Even though nobody was killed, both OMGs suffered major injuries."

And: "More importantly, many of their members are police & corrections officers, active-duty military and/or Gov't employees & contractors."

Belt Drive Betty: Mostly, the criticism of this page has demanded that The Aging Rebel prove that the Iron Order is an OMG or outlaw motorcycle gang. Which is how a biker blogger named "Belt Drive Betty" entered this information war yesterday. Betty had previously written an undated Valentine to the Iron Order. Yesterday, Betty published an entry titled "Outlaw Motorcycle Clubs & OMGs, attempting to get at the truth" in which she remarks, "The Iron Order MC has been on the receiving end of much wrath on the Aging Rebel blog." The Aging Rebel thinks Betty should at least identify this site correctly. Belt Drive Betty writes a blog on a blog site called "blogspot.com." The Aging Rebel is a news site published from 2 independent servers. Betty sniffs, "There have been articles written by the Aging Rebel (sic) that make claims that this situation was somehow a murder." Belt Drive Betty & others should also note that the indefinite article "The" is part of the name of this site. It is The Aging Rebel, like it is The Associated Press. Betty then attacks the journalism on this page as follows: "Because of one of his recent articles Feds Talk About The Iron Order, where in the Aging Rebel claims that the Iron Order are (sic) now labeled (sic) an OMG by the ATF, I made a number of calls to the ATF & finally got through to a representative at the Public Affairs Office to have the referenced report verified. "The gentleman I spoke to spent several days looking into this report & the veracity of the info on the Aging Rebel Blog (sic) with regards to this report. "Here is what this spokesperson told me: The report that the Aging Rebel refers to & quotes from is a 40 page unclassified report. "The spokesperson is not sure how the Aging Rebel came to be in possession of an emailed report that is meant for law enforcement personnel only. It is not meant for public consumption. "The spokesperson also told me that the snippet that appeared on the Aging Rebel Blog was taken out of context in terms of the greater report & that the writer of the report made a small mistake in how the 2 groups were designated in his description of an altercation between an OMG & the OMC. "He also expressed that the ATF does not designate who is an OMG & who is not, they simply deal with the violence that erupts as a result of the presence of any gang be they motorcycle related or street. "He verified with other agencies that the Iron Order MC is NOT deemed to be an OMG. "If you want to verify what I am writing here, you can do exactly as I did, call the Office of Public Affairs for the ATF at (202) 648-8500."

The Aging Rebel stands by its coverage of the Tipton murder.

The Law Abiding MC - July 21, 2014 – *U.S.A.* – By The Aging Rebel; www.AgingRebel.com - The most compelling story in July continues to be the murder of Zachariah Tipton, a member of the Black Pistons MC, which is frequently categorized as an “outlaw motorcycle club” by a (presumed) prospect with the Iron Order MC which is generally categorized as a “law abiding MC.” Today, the frequently asked questions section of the Iron Order website explains that you can join the Iron Order if: “You are male, 18 years of age, law abiding, have a cruiser style motorcycle more than 650cc not necessarily a Harley or American made, & a strong desire to do something good for your community while at the same time helping build a true international brotherhood of like minded individuals...then you Might be IOMC material.... If you believe in what the morons who post on sites like Aging Rebel, Facebook or Topix write about us then don’t come around us.” There are many empty words written about the law-abiding Iron Order, both on their site & elsewhere. In one of the darker regions of the great cyber swamp one can read, “to become a member of an IO chapter you must provide them with a background check & have had no felony convictions, & even some arrests will prohibit you from becoming a member convicted or not.” That isn’t true of course, but it is something that policemen seem to believe about the club which may explain why the prospect who gunned down Zach Tipton has been protected by them.

Robert Fernandes: The Kingman, Arizona Daily Miner pointed out the error in that last preconception this morning in a story by Scott Schulte headlined “Groups unite to transform Kingman home.” It is a human interest story about the local Iron Order chapter pitching in to help an elderly couple make some much needed repairs to their home. It is the sort of thing motorcycle clubs do all the time. Of course if, say, the Black Pistons were to do it some biker authority, maybe Steve Cook, would argue that club was merely doing public relations & cynically trying to camouflage its criminality. One of the prominently featured good guys in the story is an Iron Order member named Robert Fernandes. Fernandes told Schulte, “When I got out of jail I got involved with the Iron Order MC. I needed that camaraderie.” You can read the complete Daily Miner story here. Fernandes, who is the good citizen pictured at the top of this story, has paid his debt to society. He was convicted of armed robbery & did 5 years. He had previous convictions for theft & trafficking in stolen property. When he got out of prison he joined a motorcycle club & apparently turned his life around. But the issue of whether Fernandes is a good man or not isn’t the compelling story this month. The compelling story this month is the story the police tell. And that story assumes that there is a discernible, black & white line between the Iron Order MC which has a reputation for provoking fights & then calling the police & the Black Pistons MC which has a reputation for fighting when provoked & then not talking to police. The line the police see is actually fuzzier & grayer than they realize.

Mayfair man indicted in shooting of Pagan’s leader - July 22, 2014 - *Pennsylvania* - Mensah M. Dean; <http://www.philly.com/> - A Mayfair man arrested in March for allegedly shooting a leader of the Pagan’s MC has been indicted by a grand jury, it was revealed in court yesterday. William Damm, 44, of Friendship Street, will be formally arraigned Aug. 11, Common Pleas Judge Charles Ehrlich said. He is free on bail in the March 22 shooting of his cousin & next-door neighbor, Michael "Brick" Lane, 31. At the time of the shooting, sources said, Lane was the Pres of the Northeast Philly chapter of the Pagan's. Damm allegedly shot him in the face & shoulder after Lane & other Pagan's members

went to Damm's house during a dispute. Damm is charged with attempted murder, aggravated assault, simple assault, reckless endangerment & possession of an instrument of crime.

Navy Calls Iron Order A “Gang” - July 22, 2014 – *California / U.S.A.* – By The Aging Rebel; www.AgingRebel.com - Today the Commanding Officer of the Naval Air Weapons Station at China Lake in California issued a memorandum to the sailors & Marines under his command that called the Iron Order MC a “gang.” The memorandum has been slightly edited for clarity. The pertinent passage is in paragraph three.

The memorandum read:

1. Open & visible association with supremacist, extremist, or criminal gangs by individuals onboard Naval Air Weapons Station China Lake (NAWSCL) poses a criminal & security threat, inhibits the mission of NAWSCL, & interferes with the loyalty, morale, good order & discipline of NAWSCL personnel, & discredits the reputation of the installation & the United States Naval Service. Therefore, pursuant to & in accordance with references... the wearing or displaying of supremacist, extremist, or criminal gang colors by any person onboard NAWSCL is hereby prohibited.

2. The wearing or displaying of gang colors is defined as the visible showing on one’s person, vehicle, or personal belongings of any clothing, symbol, insignia, tattoos, paraphernalia, or photographs that are associated with a known supremacist, extremist, or criminal gang.

3. Known supremacist, extremist, or criminal gangs include, but are not limited to: Aryan Nation, Earth Liberation Front, Mexican Mafia, Mongols, Killer Latino Thugs, BMG, & Iron Order.

4. This prohibition also applies to the wearing or displaying of colors of any club, association, group, or gang that is associated with any supremacist, extremist, or criminal activity or otherwise interferes with the mission or loyalty, morale, or good order & discipline of personnel onboard NAWSCL.

5. Any persons wearing or displaying gang colors attempting to enter NAWSCL will be denied access, until such items, accessories, or displays are removed. Any persons found onboard NAWSCL wearing or displaying gang colors will be asked to remove such items, accessories, or displays. Failure to comply with this request will result in the immediate removal from base.

Additionally, any violation of this order may result in administrative or punitive action.

6. This order applies to all persons onboard NAWS China Lake, to include: military personnel, DOD civilian personnel, contractors, vendors, community pass holders, & any other customers, guests, or visitors.
