**Who is RoadBlock?** - By <http://WTRoadBlockHarrell.com> - RoadBlock 1%er grew up in Jacksonville, *Florida's* Sin City neighborhood. An admitted adrenaline junkie in his early years, he raced on NASCAR-sanctioned tracks in Florida & Georgia with many of the great drivers from that era, including Wayne Shugart, the Ezells, Eddie MacDonald, Rance Phillips, Herb Spivey & Tiny Lund. Fast cars led to fast motorcycles, & RoadBlock joined the Outlaws MC in 1971. In the years to follow, he lived the high-speed 1970s lifestyle of sex, drugs & rock & roll. That lifestyle caught up with him & he wound up serving thirty years in Fed prison, beginning in Leavenworth U.S. Penitentiary. As one Judge declared, they wanted to make an example of him to discourage others from joining MCs. Ironically, even from a prison cell, RB became well known in the U.S. & internationally because of his ability to survive, & his "never give up" attitude. As for the MCs the judge hoped to eliminate, they are stronger today than ever. In the years following 9/11, RB began to receive correspondence from young military people. Their courage, despite the traumatic injuries they sustained, profoundly affected RB. These vets returned home to a world they no longer felt comfortable in, just as many Vietnam vets did in RB's era. RB became an outspoken advocate for disabled vets, & the rights they were due. In Dec 2009, RB finally reached his mandatory release date, & was allowed to go home after almost 30 years in prison. He is now writing a fiction biker series set in the 1970s about the adventures of military vet Joe Wilson. Struggling with PTSD in a time when Vietnam vets were reviled & disrespected, Joe's rise to power in the notorious Regents MC shows one man's attempt to find his place in a changed world. Joe Wilson never gives up on his brothers, his bike or his dog.

**A Look Back at Oct 15, 1976** - Oct 15, 2015 – *Florida; U.S.A.* - By RoadBlock 1%er; <http://FreeRoadBlock.us> - On this day 39 years ago, at about 8:00 am, there was an armed attack on the Tampa Bay Chapter of the Outlaws MC by a group of individuals wearing biker apparel. This article is about the brave young man who stood his ground & defended his home & those asleep inside. He shot 3 of the unidentified attackers before he was gunned down with a .44 magnum round in the head. His name is Hank Ruby, AKA Harpo 1%er. It turns out this fiasco was a 1st time "No Knock Search Warrant" raid by a new undercover narcotics task squad. The only problem is there was no announcement & nothing identifying the attackers as LE. After a long recovery period Harpo 1%er survived with permanent massive brain damage that left him blind in one eye & paralyzed on one side. He was then charged by the State of Florida with 3 counts for the attempted murder of 3 police officers. The State's attempted murder charges were dismissed based on permanent brain damage leaving Harpo incompetent to assist in his defense. The wounded officers then filed a civil case seeking monetary damages. Once again that case was dismissed based on the permanent brain damage. In Dec 1982, Harpo 1%er was again indicted for the 3 attempted murder charges. This time in a Middle District of Florida Racketeering

Influence Corrupt Organization case against the Jacksonville & Tampa Outlaws MC chapter. The Gov't declared Harpo competent & his case was used by the Gov't to win its first ever **RICO** conviction against a MC. Harpo 1%er was convicted & received a 35 years sentence for defending his home & friends from an attack by a gang of armed & unidentified persons. To me Harpo 1%er was my brother & is a true **Hero** who is gone but will never be forgotten as long as I live.

**Original Article 1997** – Harpo 1%er - October Gun Battle - A Tribute to **Harpo 1%er** G.B.N.F. - On a cool Oct morning in 1976, Harry Ruby slept deeply, unaware that life as he knew it was about to end. The previous night, he had celebrated his 23rd birthday with friends. Harry & his girlfriend were downstairs, with the rest of his friends asleep upstairs at the 2-story house on East 93rd Ave. No one heard a van pull up outside. Armed bearded men spilled from the van & rushed up to the house. One man broke the glass in the front door, waking Harry. He was stunned to see armed men breaking into the house in broad daylight, & realized he had to defend himself & his friends immediately or die. Terrified, Harry exchanged shots with the men. In the volley of bullets, Harry was shot in the head. Over 2 dozen rounds pumped into the house before the intruders realized no one was returning fire. The following day, the Tampa Tribune carried the headlines: "3 Deputies Hurt in Cycle Gang Shootout." Harry Ruby never rated a headline because he was also known as Harpo, an Outlaw 1%er. According to the newspaper account, 13 "plainclothes" officers were attempting to serve a narcotics search warrant on the newly inhabited Outlaws Club House when they were met by gunfire. No mention was made of the disguises they wore when they broke into the house. "It was a fiasco," Sheriff's Major Cal Henderson said of what the newspaper termed "the most violent police confrontation to date with the motorcycle gang calling themselves the Outlaws." "It looked like a bloodbath in there," said a member of Tampa's Fire & Rescue Squad as he picked his way among shards of broken glass.

**Sympathetic accounts of the wounded officers'** careers & medical conditions filled the columns of the Tampa Tribune for days. Not much was said about the young biker with permanent brain damage lying in a coma at University Community Hospital. Ray Smith, an administrator at the hospital, commented that Harpo's chances of living were "very slim." Still, as he lay in a coma, Harpo was charged with 3 counts of attempted first-degree murder, possession of a short-barreled shotgun & possession of marijuana. The marijuana was found under the house when a search dog was brought in later in the afternoon of the raid. Although it was obvious the moldy quarter-pound had been there long before the Outlaws moved in a month ago, the unconscious Harpo was charged with possession. His bond was posted at \$150,000.00. Badly shaken but uninjured, the other 7 people in the house were also arrested & charged with felony possession of marijuana & weapons. Later, during testimony trying to justify their screw-up, the police said they felt they had to gain entrance to the house before anyone inside became aware of their arrival & destroyed the drugs they hoped to find. They testified they had raided the house repeatedly with uniformed officers & found no drugs. They still found no drugs, until they decided to call in a search dog from MacDill Air Force Base hours after the raid, & the canine conveniently found some ancient pot under the house.

**Further, it will never be known** if the injured officers were shot by Harpo 1%er or by their own comrades. Most evidence quickly vanished from the house, including tell-tale doors, frames & windows. Why? This horrific incident took place in an election year, with a heated rivalry for the office of sheriff. Instead of generating good publicity for the current sheriff, as intended, the disaster threatened his chances of election. Despite predictions, Harpo lived, only to face serious Fed charges because of a sheriff's publicity stunt gone wrong. A vicious Fed Prosecutor made sure that Harpo went to Fed prison, even though he was brain-damaged, partially blinded & crippled. Harpo was disabled to the point that he could not even communicate adequately with his defense attorney to present his side of the story. Harpo died in 2001 in Fed Prison without ever knowing freedom again. I want to insure that everyone knows Harpo's story. Harpo was a true 1%er who loved his brothers so much he put his life on the line in their defense. We will cherish his memory for as long as a single Outlaw 1%er exists. Harpo 1%er is now on our list of Outlaws 1%er heroes who are G. B. N. F. (Gone But Not Forgotten).

**Ride Into The 70's With Me – 2015 – Florida** – By RoadBlock 1%er; <http://WTRoadBlockHarrell.com> - The 1970's Regents-MC Series takes place in a very turbulent era of the United States' history. News media often portrays the 1960s & 1970s as an era of peace & innocence compared to our current events. Well, those of us who were around back then remember things very differently. The changes that happened to our MCs in the 1960s & 1970s were a direct result of those times, which were anything but innocent.

**Examples:** Social revolution heated up in the 1960s in this country, with young people taking to the streets. They protested the draft, the war, politics, & race. By the 1970s, these street protesters had organized into groups, & splintered into extreme factions with their own violent agendas. The Symbionese Liberation Army, best known for deliberately kidnapping publishing heiress Patricia Hearst to insure media coverage, also committed murders of citizens, bank robberies & other violence for the Black Revolution (per their manifesto). The Weatherman Underground carried out the first domestic terrorism campaign in the U.S. Their actions included riots, bombing Gov't buildings, & prison breaks, including that of LSD guru Timothy Leary. In 1965, 3 East Coast members of RAM (The Revolutionary Action Movement) were charged with conspiring to blow up the Statue of Liberty, the Liberty Bell, & the Washington Monument. From RAM, many other black power groups evolved. Black Panther leader Eldridge Cleaver endorsed guerilla warfare & the rape of white women as revenge against the white male. In his book, he admitted "practicing" on black women in the ghetto, then moving "across the tracks" to prey on white women. And of course, the FBI manipulated & contributed to the violence. As an example, the FBI sent an anonymous letter to the leader of the Blackstone Rangers, a Chicago radical Islamic group, claiming that the Panthers were threatening his life. Similar action was taken to intensify a gang war between the Black Panther Party & a group called the US Organization, which led to beatings, torture, & several deaths. FBI agents claimed credit for instigating the violence between the 2 groups. Skyjackings from almost every US airport to Cuba became commonplace, usually by a fugitive or self-styled revolutionary who mistakenly thought Castro's Havana would be a better place to live. There were 69 successful skyjackings from 1968 to 1973. Unsuccessful skyjackings usually meant the pilots were killed, or the plane ran out of fuel

with all aboard falling to their deaths into the sea. The 1970s were also the deadliest decade in L.E. history, when a total of 2,276 officers died. And that was just here in the US. In 1972, we all witnessed the Munich Massacre at the Olympics, when members of the Israeli Olympic Team were taken hostage by the Black September group. By the time it ended, eleven Israeli athletes & coaches, & one German police officer, were murdered by the terrorist group. In Ireland, 479 people died in The Troubles in 1972, more than in any other year of the conflict. In Brescia, Italy, the Piazza Della Loggia bombing in May 1974 killed 8 people & wounded over 90. In August of that same year, a bomb exploded in a passenger car of the Rome-Brenner express train, killing 12 & injuring 44. In Great Britain, pub bombings occurred on a regular basis. In 1974-1975, London was subject to a 14-month bombing & shootings campaign. Some 40 explosions rocked the capital, leaving 35 people dead & many more injured. As you can see, Violence & Terrorism did not start on Sept 11. Drug use also exploded during this time. Acid, pot, speed, downers, cocaine & heroin were in their heyday. There was something for everybody, from hippies to housewives to corporate executives. The problem had accelerated so quickly that LE couldn't keep up, & were fighting each other across their own bureaucratic lines for power. Pres Nixon was ultimately responsible for the creation of a single Fed agency to coordinate the Gov'ts drug control activities: the DEA. This happened in July 1973, & stepped up the drug war to a new level of violence, in America & overseas. In the middle of all this, the American MCs were expanding. The biker lifestyle attracted veterans returning from the hell-holes of the Viet Nam War. These young men had become adrenalin junkies from combat & constantly living in fear minute to minute. They had learned to kill at an instant's notice to stay alive themselves, & carried shrapnel & bone fragments under their own skin from friends blown to pieces beside them. After surviving the worst kind of modern warfare, these men made it home, only to be condemned by those who hid behind college deferments. Abandoned by the politicians who sent them to Viet Nam in the first place, unable to fit back in to normal family life, these men found a place among the brotherhood of kindred spirits in America's MCs. With this new influx of members, the MCs were constantly starting up new chapters across America. This in turn caused serious conflict between the MCs as everyone tried to expand their territory. All of the larger clubs, not just the 1%er clubs, were involved in these wars. To wear a 1%er club patch meant your life was on the line 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Every single time you rode your motorcycle away from your club house, you never knew if you would run into a situation that could cost your patch, your motorcycle or even your life. The rivalry meant men were getting shot, stabbed, blown up & severely beaten on a regular basis. At each Club House, the walls were covered with "trophies": patches from other clubs pulled & hung upside down in disrespect. Hardly any of the 1%er Clubs got along, & got along with very few of the others. The motto each 1%er club lived by was: "If you ain't in my club, you ain't shit." And "We are the best, fuck the rest." The adrenalin rush of constantly living on the edge was addictive. Add to this the ongoing partying, the drug high, the elated feeling you got from riding with a bunch of your 1%er brothers just like you, who put their life on the line every time they put on their patch, with only each other to rely on—this is the Club as Joe Wilson knew it in 1971.

**The Motorcycle Gang Intelligence Expert** – Sept 29, 2015 – U.S.A. – By The Aging Rebel; [www.AgingRebel.com](http://www.AgingRebel.com) - “My name is Jeremy Sheetz,” the short, dark haired man in the grey suit says. “I’m an Intel Operations Specialist with the ATF. I’ve been with the ATF since 2003. Since 2006 I’ve been working bikers.” Sheetz wears a dark blue shirt for maximum gangster effect. His receding hair is combed straight back & he wears Satan’s beard. “Basically right now I support a lot of cases. Doing a lot of teaching. I’m very fortunate. I get to travel. I work a lot of runs like Sturgis every year. The Hells Angels USA Run. Bandidos USA Run. I just came back from Australia. We were assisting them in how to work long term investigations, how to change their laws. So that’s just some of the things I do.” It is a startlingly frank admission about the way the Global War on Terror has metamorphosed into a Global War on MCs. Seconds after seizing the podium Sheetz brags that the American ATF is authoring laws in Australia designed to make life harder for motorcyclists. Then he abruptly announces, “I’m not going to talk about Waco.” He says it in a way that implies that he knows a great deal about Waco but that he cannot share what he knows even to his audience of trustworthy policemen, who are about to be privy to secrets the press & other ordinary people are not important enough to know. The Waco secrets are too important. Careers may be at risk.

**Exclusive Leaked:** Sheetz craves celebrity which is one of the reasons he is speaking at the Gangs Across the Carolinas Conference at the Pinehurst Resort in North Carolina on Aug 13. The event is sponsored by the North Carolina Gang Investigators Association. Only sworn LE officers are allowed to attend. Sheetz is the senior motorcycle gang intelligence analyst for the ATF. He is the author of an annual report called OMGs & the Military. After the Twin Peaks Massacre in Waco last May 17, portions of the July 2014 version of the report were reprinted by numerous mainstream publications. On May 22, for example, The Huffington Post ran a “first look” story about Sheetz report under the headline “Exclusive: Leaked Report Profiles Military, Police Members Of Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs.” Sheetz lecture is glib & fatuous. His syntax is a mélange of Mickey Spillane & Tonto. And, his message is that biker violence is about to be a major problem in the Carolinas. Whether the Carolinas know it or not.

**Cops Believe:** A proof of Sheetz wide influence occurred last Sat when 3 Outlaws were arrested in Rhode Island – basically for the crime of driving through the Providence Plantations. They were blatantly targeted arrests based on Sheetz’ intelligence reports. The day after those arrests, a Rhode Island State Police Major named Joseph Philbin told a Providence television: “The Outlaws are one the of biggest MCs or gangs in the country, & the fact that they are establishing a presence in Rhode Island is alarming to us because sometimes they can bring forth some violence & criminal activity.” “New England is considered to belong to the Hells Angels.” “The Hells Angels have had a presence in Rhode Island as long as I’ve been on the state police, the last 20 to 25 years. So the fact that the Outlaws are trying to maintain or create a presence here could create a problem.” Philbin learned what he thinks he knows from Sheetz. The words & ideas are Sheetz. The ATF intelligence analyst tells the North Carolina audience about what he believes to be the growing “problem” of “Outlaws expansion in Connecticut, Rhode Island & Massachusetts. On Aug 18, 2014 he lectures, 2 Outlaws attacked 3 Phantom Lords. On Nov 1, “approximately” 5 Hells Angels attacked an Outlaw with bats & brass knuckles at an Outlaw clubhouse. On Nov 13, an Outlaw’s motorcycle was “torched” in

front of an Outlaw clubhouse. On Dec 3, a vehicle belonging to a former Outlaws spouse was set on fire.” “I’m gonna give you a full review of what’s going on in the United States,” he promises

**Inflammatory Junk:** Much of his presentation is a tempest of junk statistics & arbitrary assertions. “Thirty-eight percent of all Hells Angels in the United States are felons.” “Of the 300 plus OMGs that are entrenched in the USA, the Hells Angels, Pagan’s, Outlaws, Vagos & Bandidos are characterized as part of the Big Five.” Most of it is in self-important official speak. “Over a 24-month period ending January 1, 2012, 284 total acts of violence related incidents have been reported.” Some of it is soporific. “Between 2012 & 2014 the Pagan’s, HAMC, Outlaws, Bandidos, SOS, Mongols & Vagos are considered the Dominant 7. Together they committed 260 violent acts.” Most of it is inflammatory. “This is what is coming to North Carolina.” He plays a surveillance video. “This is outside a Pagan’s tattoo studio in Long Island. This is a Pagan named Road Block, a Pagan’s Sergeant at Arms, being assaulted by 3 Hells Angels & a group of Demon Knights. Road Block walks outside & goes, ‘Oh shit.’ The Pagan’s inside the tattoo parlor lock the door & leave Road Block on his own. “Inside the tattoo parlor is a guy named J.R.,” Sheetz tells the crowd of cops something they want to hear. “J.R. was the chapter president of Long Island at the time. And he’s basically, a big sissy.” “The ironic thing about this situation is that at the time we had an ATF undercover as a hang around for this chapter. Because of some internal conflicts within the Pagan’s, they told him to go home that weekend instead of being in the tattoo parlor. So this was not only an ‘oh shit’ moment for the Pagan’s but it was also an ‘oh shit’ moment for the ATF. Because what are you gonna do if you have an ATF cover on that scene? None of these guys was ever, ever charged.”

**Inside Knowledge:** “We know who these guys are,” Sheetz brags. “We stand right in front of them. We take their photos. I write the OMG Military report. I get fuck yous all the time. I put my phone number right in there. They call. They just don’t like us. That’s good. That means we’re doing our jobs. We’re putting them in jail. And, that’s what our job is to do.” “My job as the Intel operations specialist is to make sure that my ATF undercovers, or the informers & the case agents have everything they need when they do one of these cases. When you work one of these cases they don’t go by the name John Smith. They go by monikers. So you gotta know their monikers. They don’t always live at the house that’s in Lexus Nexus. A lot of their bikes, their cars are registered in their females’ names. Old lady’s names. Sometimes other dudes names. This is what you have to be cognizant of. This is what we think about. We think about clubs like the Hells Angels, the Pagan’s, the Outlaws.” He proceeds to demonize club members. He shows a slide of “a food drive that takes part every year in Virginia Beach, The first Sat of the month. The media’s out there. The radio stations are out there. They meet at Pembroke Mall. All biker clubs to include the African-American biker clubs, the multi-racial, the expanded associational, it doesn’t matter. They show up. They donate food. They drive the food to the food bank. ... But this is not what they really are. This is not them. This is the outside. This is what they want you to see. But when you work these guys you see this is all smoke & mirrors. It’s all bullshit.” He talks about the then mayor of Batesville, Indiana. “The Mayor of Batesville, while he was the mayor, was also a member of the Klan. After he left that, he became a member of the Invaders. This is him now. He’s now the chapter president of the Indiana Nomads.” Nine days after the conference in North

Carolina, a man named Rick Fledderman who was Mayor of Batesville, Indiana resigned his office after he was charged with patronizing a prostitute.

**White Ideology:** Sheetz, who comes across as a cubicle tough guy, describes MCs as “a white ideology.” “But I’ll show you how that is changing because they are basically running out of people to bring on as prospects because there are so many clubs. So a lot of these clubs that used to be dominant white are now bringing on Hispanic gang members. The guys who look African-American. They’re really Dominican or Puerto Rican.” “The farther north the Bandidos go,” he says, “the whiter & fatter they get. The farther east the Mongols go, the fatter & whiter they get.” “Okay, what’s a one percenter? Any group of motorcyclists who have made a voluntary commitment to band together to abide by their organization’s rules, basically bylaws, enforced by violence, it’s all about violence, to engage in activities that bring them & their club into repeated conflicts.” The real problem, he seems to argue, is that the “white ideology” of MCs is so appealing that it is spreading out of control. “There’s so many clubs, they’re running out of room.”

**Bureaucratic Ideology:** Sheetz touches on the increasing federalization of all LE in the United States. “Everybody looks at ATF & they say, ‘Hey DOJ, FBI? You guys classify these guys as a gang?’ Nope. The states do. But what we did do in 2010 is we put them on this high priority, organized crime list. Top organized crime list. And as you can see La Cosa Nostra is at the top. At the time, the Hells Angels were number 7, which is pretty good. So basically, if you were to start a Hells Angels investigation & you work with FBI or ATF or DEA, they want you to call the Attorney General’s Office & say, ‘Hey, we got a case going & we want to make sure we don’t have a blue on blue situation.’ That occurs still to this day. Because there are a lot of other things that have to do with like DEA so you need to run it through the Fusion Center, That way you’re not have any kind of conflict with another case.” Sheetz explains how the ATF, FBI, the State Dept & the Dept of Homeland Security all work together to make life hard for MC members. “So at the same time,” Sheetz begins, “the Attorney General’s Office did this, the Hells Angels World Run which occurs every 5 years in the United States, was going on in Laconia, New Hampshire. So Customs & Border Patrol & the State Dept said, ‘We’re gonna come in & we’re gonna say you’re a foreign member, we’re gonna put you on a list. And when you come to the airport, you can’t enter the United States.’” “Now myself, my couple of guys, said ‘This is bullshit.’ Why is it bullshit? Because what they’re saying is you have a propensity to come into the United States to commit a crime. But there was never a precedent set. But they did it anyway. So at the time, the Hells Angels said this is bullshit. So when we were working the World Run at Laconia, there wasn’t many members from Brazil or England. They would get to the airport & they’d say, ‘Oh! You gotta go back. CBP & the State Dept won’t allow you to come in.’ Some guys even flew into Boston or New York. They turned them around. They turned around their families, wives, kids, So now you’re kinda stretching the envelope a little bit.” One of the women eventually “turned around” under this policy was Izzy Wildheart. Wildheart advocates for incarcerated Hells Angels on a website called “Big House Crew.” The site also advocates for non-Hells Angels who Wildheart thinks have been treated unfairly & in 2009 she was awarded The President’s Volunteer Service Award by Barack Obama. The award stated, “Your volunteer service demonstrates the kind of commitment...that moves

America a step closer to its great promise.” In July 2012 Wildheart was denied entry into the United States because she talks sympathetically about Hells Angels & because she is married to a Hells Angel. In 2012, she told The Aging Rebel, “I was due to fly to New York State to visit a friend of mine who is married to a Native American for her daughter’s graduation party,” she said. “I had been granted an ESTA, a kind of Visa waiver. I was met at Heathrow by Homeland Security who after a lot of fucking around, calling Washington’s Homeland Security who informed Heathrow my case needed to be dealt with here in London or I would be detained in New York. I am now officially under the Terrorist Act & Criminal Organization Act & banned from setting foot in the good old US of A for life, due to my association with the club. My mother is an American citizen, I have 3 sisters & a brother who live in the States & I have no criminal record, but ‘the doors are firmly shut’ to me.” “The thing that’s ironic is the Hells Angels were gonna sue,” Sheets rambles on. In fact, in April 2012 the Hells Angels Motorcycle Corporation of Westlake Village, Calif actually did file suit against Janet Napolitano, The Secretary of the Dept of Homeland Security, Secretary of State Hillary Rodham Clinton & Alejandro Mayorkas who is the Director of U.S. Citizenship & Immigration Services. The suit disputed the official policy that declared “the Hells Angels, the Outlaws, Bandidos, & the Mongols” to be organized crime groups. That policy also asserts “that these groups operated as permanent organized criminal societies. Active membership in these groups could reasonably be considered to involve a permanent association with criminal activities...” Sheetz is hazy on the details. “So they’re gonna sue the United States Gov’t for not letting their core members come in & they’re saying there’s a propensity to come into the United States & commit a violent act. Even though there’s no precedent ever set. So on that list...So on that list at the time they put down the Hells Angels. But in 2013 they updated that list. They put the Bandidos, the Vagos, the Mongols & the Pagan’s. There was a problem there. The Pagan’s aren’t international so nobody from international is flying into America. And then they forgot to put on the Outlaws. Oops! To this day the Pagan’s are still on the list & the Outlaws are not on the list but we’re trying to get that changed. But anybody who works for a Gov’t knows it takes a long time to get things done.”

**Gang Enhancement Laws:** Throughout his presentation, Sheetz urges the cops in the room to lobby for gang enhancement laws. “States do have gang enhancement laws. Even places like Calif. The last time I looked there were like 50 members of the Vagos, Hells Angels, Mongols & other smaller clubs who have been charged with a gang enhancement. So if you commit a burglary, an assault or maim somebody & there’s 3 or more guys, they can slap a gang enhancement charge on you as well as whatever you’re being charged with – burglary or assault. And you can get one to 15 years added onto your sentence.” “If you’re a member of the Hells Angels & you plead into that gang enhancement you’re done. Automatically kicked out. They just had it happen in Arizona. A guy pled to the gang. They kicked him out immediately. Good member. He’d been a member about 4 years. He pled to it. He assaulted a guy. He pled to the gang. Booted the very next day. You go to places like Arizona, California, Minnesota – Minnesota’s now getting it, Georgia’s working on it, Nevada, Virginia, Virginia’s gonna copy exactly what Arizona’s done. Take what they’ve done. Change your state’s name.” Sheetz talks about the limits of ATF’s intelligence gathering. “We don’t know much about the Pagan’s because they

don't do much electronically. Basically, they use FAX machines. They're outdated." "The Outlaws, we don't have anybody right now who can tell us what's going on, on the inside." Sheetz gives the budding gang experts his take on the Gov'ts attempts to seize the Mongols MC's insignia. "We thought this year in May it was done.... If they go through seizing these colors, a message is going to be sent, These colors are property of the United States Gov't.... I can honestly tell you, after this is over ATF isn't going after another set of colors. It takes so long. It was manpower intensive. And we just don't have the manpower or the money."

**Mongols And Angels:** "Shit's gonna occur," Sheetz warns his spell bound audience & then he spills out the official Gov't narrative of events involving the Mongols & the Hells Angels in the Southwest over the last 18 months. It is intended as a warning for North Carolina. "March 22 2014, On that day in San Bernardino, the Vagos had a mandatory run. The Hells Angels had a West Coast officers' meeting. And, the Mongols had a mandatory run. So you knew something was gonna happen. So 4 Hells Angels & 5 hang arounds were coming off an exit ramp & they saw approximately about 55 Mongols. These guys try to run the Mongols off the road. That doesn't work. Next thing you know on the side of the road these guys are in a knife fight. Two Hells Angels got stabbed really bad. Five mile backup on the road. "So right after that. Raleigh, North Carolina. We have never seen a Hells Angels support club, basically drop their colors & go to an adversary. Guess what happened in Raleigh? They were sick of being the bitches. They basically said to the Hells Angels, 'Hey.' Conversation with the Mongols. Several of them patched over. And they see each other a couple of days later. Incident occurs in a bar. Hells Angel gets the bad end of that stick, Gets beat down. But you now have an incident in North Carolina between the Hells Angels & the Mongols. "Meanwhile across the country. Reno, Nevada. Noon on a Sunday. Bunch of Hells Angels are in a bar. 'Cause we all drink at noon on Sundays. Bunch of Mongols roll by. Shots are fired. Nobody's hit. Nobody's prosecuted. Nobody's even charged. But this shit's starting to really heat up now. "Sept 20. Corona, California. Bunch of Mongols are leaving to go to a party. They ride up the Highway. Three members & 3 hang arounds. Bunch of Hells Angels pull up. Pull off on an exit ramp. As they make a right the Hells Angels make a right. And a shooting occurs. The guy in the back, who was just discharged from the United States Navy, is blown off his bike. "Now the good thing about Southern California is John Ciccone & Darrin Kozlowski have an OMG task force. About 35 different guys & they have been doing this for so long. So do to intelligence, they heard the Mongols were gonna retaliate. And these guys who are talking aren't just like shitheads. These guys are former Sureno gang members that have moved up the ranks & now they are Mongols. They are heavy hitters. So they found out, you know what. We're gonna retaliate against the Hells Angels. "So October 27, John Ciccone's task force gets a search warrant, uh...eight on that day. Retribution for shooting that hang around off the back of his bike. So they go to do a search warrant at a guy's house. Named David Martinez. Violent, violent Mongol. As the TAC team gets ready. Officer gets hit in the back. Shot & killed. So eventually they get in the house. They find a shotgun. But his defense was. I didn't shoot him. He was shot by somebody in his TAC team. But nobody in the TAC team had a shotgun. And then he said, well, they didn't announce themselves. It was all on video. So the bad thing about this is this is a horrendous thing. You never want to see someone shot. Never ever. "So now we fast forward to

February, Arizona. Because these guys are international. They're all across the United States. This is Patrick Eberhardt. Cave Creek member which is a suburb of Phoenix. His father is the West Coast Treasurer. Cave Creek Chapter Pres. This little kid is basically driving around. He sees a pack of Hells Angels & he thinks he knows them. So his best friend, who is not a Hells Angel, sees the Hells Angels & they make a quick U-turn & they ride right up to a traffic light. He looks to the right. He looks to the left & he drops off the bike. And that's all you see. That's what the witnesses said. "Do we think the Mongols did it? Sure. I talk to the detective probably 2, 3 times a week. Great guy. Works Hells Angels. Works Mongols. He works a lot of clubs. He knows they did it. We all know they did it. We just don't think there's enough evidence right now to bring any charges." Most of what Sheetz claims is twisted. He starts with ideas & sees what he wants to see – what will prove what he sees in his head. He is obviously neither bright nor insightful or even particularly well informed. But he is paid to have opinions. That's what "intelligence" means, really. A collection of opinions. Then he tells them to the world. And the world believes.

**Christie Still Hard To Ignore** - Oct 1, 2015 – *California* – By The Aging Rebel; [www.AgingRebel.com](http://www.AgingRebel.com) - George Christie Jr., the longtime Pres of the Ventura charter of the Hells Angels MC, continues to demand & get attention. Christie was expelled from his old club, debriefed, spent 7 months in prison & came out destitute. Now he is a reality television personality with a book deal &, recently, his own billboard on the Sunset Strip. It is a success story. And, as Napoleon once famously remarked, "You can't make an omelet without breaking some eggs." Christie has a couple of lawyers who do his egg breaking for him.

**Mead:** Last March, after British director Nick Mead pulled a film he had made about Christie titled *The Last American Outlaw*, Christie's attorney daughter Moriya Lynn Christie wrote Mead a letter on her father's behalf that bluntly threatened to sue Mead, who had already spent \$200,000 of his own money on the film, into bankruptcy if he didn't do what George wanted. "It seems that the appropriate remedy is for you to sign over your rights in the Venture & in the Documentary to Nikki (Christie –George Christie's wife). The transaction can be structured whereby Nikki & the Venture indemnify you from any claims that arise from the distribution of the Documentary with an errors & omissions insurance policy secured in order to address any such claims. Otherwise, you are likely looking at a lawsuit for damages & specific performance wherein you are going to incur over \$100,000 in legal fees whereas my relationship with Nikki will substantially reduce the attorneys' fees she will be required to spend, if any at all." "You simply cannot take your ball & go home." More recently a lawyer named James Devine, who wrote the contract that defined Mead & Christie's obligations to each other, has been blustering at 2 of Christie's other adversaries.

**Li'l Georgie's Motorcycle:** One dispute involves a 1989 H-D FXRS that George's late son, George Christie III apparently sold or gave to a friend, who asked not to be named, in 2013. The younger Christie died at the beginning of Aug. The bike is registered in the new owner's name & he still possesses it, but the former Ventura charter chief claims the bike belongs to him & is threatening to sue to get it back & also to collect damages. The man has been told that his "continued retention of the motorcycle constitutes conversion under Calif law." The dispute has lingered since April. It seems like a curious overreaction. Christie who has

had 2 hips replaced rarely rides these days. And, possession is still 9-tenths of the law. Last month, Christie went public with the dispute in a blog post titled "Who Stole Li'l Georgie's Motorcycle." Five months after it began, he wrote about the dispute as if it was something that had just then come up. "There are limits, even in the world of Outlaws. Or so I thought," Christie wrote on Sept 13, about 5 weeks after his oldest son died. "Many things have opened my eyes as I journey through this new century. Every mid-Sept I pause to remember watching the twin towers collapse from acts of cowards. I have seen something else crumbling too — the outlaw motorcycle culture, a world I had called home since 1966. "As many of you may know, my family has been trying to come to terms with the loss of my son, George Christie III, who passed away unexpectedly a few weeks ago. It has hit me & my oldest daughter, Moriya, hard... The depth of the loss is indescribable &, frankly, inconsolable. "In the midst of our grief we have discovered Georgie's FXRS H-D is missing. The motorcycle was a gift I bought him the day he graduated from high school. Although he would have never said it outright, the fact that he has kept it all these years tells me it held a very special place in his heart. And it held a very special place in mine. I can still see his face & hear his words on the day I gave it to him. 'Thanks Pops' he said, as he looked into my eyes & smiled, showing how much he really meant it."

**Snitch:** The other dispute has been more blunt & less sentimental. Four days after Christie's public plea to recover the motorcycle that was once his, Devine wrote a cease & desist letter demanding that man named William E. Gaddie stop insulting America's newest reality star. Devine demanded that Gaddie "publicly retract" his "defamatory & false light statements regarding Mr. Christie on Mr. Gaddie's personal Facebook page & the Facebook pages 'George Christies (sic) a Fraud,' 'George Christie (sic) a Fraud,' & 'Outbad Chronicles,' & the YouTube submission from 'Chris Georgie.' Devine also alleges that Gaddie "made false & disparaging comments to Mr. Christie, Mrs. Christie, & their son Finn while they sat outside a business establishment in Ojai, California. Mr. Gaddie called Mr. Christie a 'fucking rat,' 'snitch,' 'pig sucker,' & 'fucking queer.' Mr. Gaddie also stated that Mr. Christie should have been killed instead of Ray Glore. Thereafter, Mr. Gaddie told Mrs. Christie that he would 'see her later' despite the fact that there was no reason for Mrs. Christie to ever 'see' Mr. Gaddie. It was obvious that Mr. Gaddie was threatening to inflict further harm on Mrs. Christie at a later date & time."

**Gaddie Replies:** Gaddie responded on Sept 21. He wrote: "As many people already know George has tried to use intimidation & scare tactics to manipulate for years. I received this hypocritical letter from George Christie Jr., much like the one he had written to Nick Mead. George thinks it is okay to go on television & talk about people in his 'Outbad Chronicles' but he doesn't like when people tell about the side of George Christie they know. He keeps trying to delete comments about him that he simply doesn't like. "You can't have it both ways George! You created a Facebook Page as a 'Public Figure.' People have opinions about that, 'You simply cannot take your ball & go home.' As his usual method of operation, this letter is full of lies it seems he just won't tell the truth. I want it to be known I did go to jail & I was on non-association as part of the terms I was sentenced with from the Judge. I believe George is the one who arranged these terms as he screwed over many others to benefit himself. I am a former member in Good Standing, & I have nothing but the utmost respect

for the club & its life style. "There are so many people he has done wrong & screwed over it could be any number of them making these Facebook page's & Video's. This will keep his lawyer busy endlessly writing letters. The bottom line is the videos contain truth he doesn't want heard." Like sands through the hourglass, so are the days of outlaws lives.

**Another Iron Coffins Murder Charge - Oct 2, 2015 - Michigan**  
– By The Aging Rebel; [www.AgingRebel.com](http://www.AgingRebel.com) - Iron Coffins MC member Matthew Starkweather was arrested Thu in Battle Creek, Michigan & charged with the murder of former club president Lee J. "Leeroy" Taylor on New Year's Day 2012. Again. According to local police, Taylor & Iron Coffin member Matthew Starkweather got into a fight at a club party over a debt of \$2,500. Starkweather knocked Taylor down. Another patch holder named John Lindahl III ordered everybody who wasn't a club member out of the clubhouse. When police arrived at 6 a.m. Taylor was dead of multiple blows to the head & Starkweather had been stabbed in the neck. Police charged Starkweather with murder on the spot. They later also charged Lindahl & another witness named Mario "Paco" Barroso as accessories.

**Barroso:** Barroso made a deal to testify in return for immunity from prosecution but he didn't testify to the satisfaction of the prosecutor who was then a man named Jeff Kabot. Kabot lost. Barroso couldn't remember anything & all 3 men, who were the only witnesses to Taylor's death, walked. The charges were dismissed. Starkweather & Lindahl said that Taylor had attacked them with a knife & a baton & they defended themselves. Police said they defended themselves with a club & the butt of a shotgun. A new prosecutor named David Gilbert was elected in November 2012 & early this year he decided to go after the 3 men again. The first man charged was Barroso. According to Gilbert, Taylor was murdered, not killed in self-defense, & Barroso aided & abetted that murder by handing either Starkweather or Lindahl the shotgun. Since defending one's self against a murder charge tends to be economically ruinous, Barroso pled no contest to manslaughter in August with the expectation that he would be sentenced to about 3 years. Last month a judge sentenced him to a prison term of 71 to 180 months which, because Barroso is now 66, means he may die behind the barbed wire.

**Self-Righteous Cruelty:** Obviously, Gilbert's prosecution has more to do with a public display of self righteous cruelty than with justice or public safety. Yesterday it was Starkweather's turn to start the long climb up the pyramid steps to the sacrificial alter. Starkweather's lawyer, a man named J. Thomas Schaeffer, told the Battle Creek Enquirer, "I think this charge is ill-advised because the right decision was made before & it is a classic case of self-defense. My guy was on his back & had a knife to his neck." "This case had laid dormant for 3 years & I anticipate the same result will happen. Mr. Gilbert is causing people a disruption in their lives & costing them great sums of money." Gilbert said publically, "It is a cold case that has been reopened. I don't know why it was originally dismissed. The attorney who was handling it is not here anymore. But after a review & upon further investigation it has been reissued." Gilbert also said his investigation into the case was "continuing."

**Iron Order MC Metastasising** - Oct 5, 2015 – U.S.A. – By The Aging Rebel; [www.AgingRebel.com](http://www.AgingRebel.com) - The Iron Order MC, which has branded itself as “the law abiding MC” & has been the largest aspirational MC in the world, has lost about 1,000 members to a brand new club called the Iron Legacy MC. The new club claims members throughout the United States & has announced 9 “international” & regional officers.

**Running Things:** Ray “Izod” Lubesky is the international president of the new club. Lubesky is a former fast food executive with Cinnabon, Ponderosa Steakhouses & Papa John’s Pizza who now runs a painting company franchise in Palm Harbor, Florida. Lubesky was the longtime president of the Iron Order. Craig “Playboy” Cabral of Assonet, Massachusetts in the new club’s internat’l V.P.. Michael “Taxman” Falcon, a tax preparer from Swansea, Massachusetts will be the international business manager. Bob “Freon” Souza, an air conditioner repairman from Fall River, Massachusetts will be the new sergeant at arms. John “Just One More” Marsden, a recent Iron Order regional director from Hopkinton, Massachusetts, will be a regional director for the new club. Rick Weeble of Louisville, Kentucky, a former international business manager for the Iron Order will be the Iron Legacy’s Central United States director. Roanld “Kingpin” Candelaria, the owner of Kingpin Real Estate in Temecula, California & a former Iron Order regional director will be the Iron Legacy’s West Coast director. James “Whiskey” Arnold, a history buff from Nashville will be in charge of the new club’s “Internal Affairs/Professional Standards” & Joe “Professor” Loiacano, an original member of the Iron Order who sells fruit & produce in Louisville, will be an “advisor.”

**Real Beginning:** In a statement, the new club declared, “We chose to turn back to the path set 11 years ago & now we will start our 12th year as Iron Legacy MC. Not a new beginning but a return to the real beginning that brought us together years ago.” In 2011, Jason Nark & William Bender of the Philadelphia Daily News wrote, “Authorities say that the soaring popularity of the Sons of Anarchy TV show – the most watched in FX’s history – could be contributing to a disturbing trend: Weekend warriors, no longer content to simply ride together, are forming small MCs & dabbling in the outlaw lifestyle.” Lubesky read the comment on The Aging Rebel & was flattered. “That is exactly how & why the Iron Order MC was started... in a garage in Jeffersonville, Indiana,” Lubesky said. “We formed our own club with our own rules. We didn’t care what anyone else thought about us or what bullshit they spread about what we were doing. We swore to stick together & fought internally & externally every threat that came our way. We never backed down & never changed direction because some organization or club criticized & condemned us. We stood our ground & pushed forward whenever & wherever we found like-minded men with iron balls who wanted the same things we did. We found there were a whole lot of them out there all over the world.” Lubesky thought Nark & Bender made “a strong statement of what was going on in the world of clubs & we happened to pioneer some of it. For that I am profoundly proud.”

**Aspirational Club:** The Aging Rebel has since described such clubs comprised of “Weekend warriors, no longer content to simply ride together,” who form “small MCs &” dabble “in the outlaw lifestyle” as “aspirational MCs” to differentiate them from traditional MCs. The Iron Legacy MC appears to be the newest of these aspirational clubs. In his first statement as new Pres of the Iron Legacy, Lubesky wrote his members, “We have no reason to

hide or be secretive. We need to be above board & honest. We must have the highest integrity & let those morons grovel in their shit piles. When you turn the lights on the roaches run for cover. We are not the roaches. Let them do the running. Let’s not hide behind anything. If the assholes want to know anything about what we’re doing let them call & ask & we should answer. I am sure we will have plants & spies. It will not matter as we will hide nothing.”

**Chosen Son Gets Probation** - Oct 6, 2015 – Maryland – By The Aging Rebel; [www.AgingRebel.com](http://www.AgingRebel.com) - Eric Christopher Jansen, a retired Baltimore policeman & a member of the Chosen Sons MC, was sentenced to “probation before sentencing” last Fri for his part in a fight with members of the Iron Order MC. Jansen had been charged with 1st & 2nd-degree assault, theft & robbery. Iron Horsemen MC member Eric Lloyd “Animal” Calkins was sentenced to 2 years incarceration with all but 60 days suspended. Calkins had been charged with 2 counts of first-degree assault, 5 counts of second-degree assault, assault with a deadly weapon & strong arm robbery. A third man, Darrin Shiflett, was also sentenced to “probation before sentencing.” All 3 pled guilty last July to one count of 2nd-degree assault.

**Blue Marlin Brawl:** The charges resulted from a brawl with Iron Order members Timothy “Sentinel” Taylor, Timothy J. “PourHonie” Kielian, Seth Daniel Gerhart, James Charles Leblanc & John Anthony Hayes on Feb 7 Kenny B’s Blue Marlin in Dundalk, Maryland. The 5 Iron Order members were drinking in the bar with several women when Calkins entered the bar & a fight quickly ensued. Jansen joined the fight after he walked into the bar & observed 4 of the Iron Order members hitting Calkins in the head with collapsible batons, Calkins is a veteran who suffered a traumatic brain injury during his military service in Iraq. Surveillance video showed Jansen pushing Kielian’s wife out of his way & punching Kielian in the face twice. Kielian is the business manager of the Baltimore Iron Order chapter. Kielian, appeared at Friday’s & asked the judge to sentence Jansen harshly. “The point is, there were people in there that night that were doing nothing wrong,” Kielian told the judge. “It’s inexcusable.”

**Texas DPS Version** - Oct 14, 2015 – Texas – By The Aging Rebel; [www.AgingRebel.com](http://www.AgingRebel.com) - A Texas Dept of Public Safety Criminal Investigations Division Investigative Report titled “Bandidos/Cossacks” written by DPS agent Christopher Frost the day after the Twin Peaks Massacre seems to provide the basis for what will be the eventual prosecution of some number of people Waco prosecutors have connected to the incident. The report is not necessarily an accurate description of what occurred. Rather it serves the same function as Reports of Investigation written by Fed police forces. It is full of assertions that magically become “evidence” by being written down. Like most of these documents it is at least as interesting for what it does not say as for what it does say. Frost is assigned to the Waco office of the Texas DPS. The report is about 2,100 words long. It is unusually long for a police report & it is carefully worded which, together with standard techniques of internal literary analysis, betrays that the document has gone through multiple drafts. Much of it appears to have been written before May 17. It was “approved by DPS “Lieutenant Steven Schwartz” Schwartz testified for the prosecution at multiple examining trials held for Waco defendants. Both Frost & Schwartz were at the Twin Peaks during the shooting.

**The Report:** According to Frost & Schwartz, “in late March 2015,” Texas DPS agents “learned of an incident that occurred on March 22, 2015 on Interstate 35 in the City of Lorena.” Lorena is about 5 miles south of Waco. “At about 3:15 pm on Mar 22, 2015 the Lorena PD was dispatched to Interstate 35 southbound lanes near the 323 milepost to a fight in progress.” Witnesses told police “that a blue Ford pickup, a green Nissan Titan & a white Dodge pickup forced a male subject on a motorcycle against the inside barrier wall & to a stop. 8 to 10 male subjects exited the vehicles & began assaulting the male with a chain, a baton, & possibly a pipe. The male motorcycle rider was later identified as (Rolando Campos) a member of the Bandido (sic) **Outlaw Motorcycle Gang.**” Police told the DPS that members of the Cossacks MC carried out the assault & that “the Bandido OMG & Cossacks MC were at odds due to the Cossacks wearing the bottom ‘Texas’ rocker on the back lower portion of their jackets.” Frost then editorializes that “the Cossacks MC is known to be involved in criminal activity, including but not limited to, narcotics trafficking, weapons trafficking, assault, extortion & murder.”

**The Lorena Police:** The Lorena PD has been mentioned frequently in official & unofficial evidence about the Twin Peaks Massacre. According to Frost, the DPS first learned from the Lorena police “that the normal Coalition of Clubs (COC) meeting that usually is held in Austin was suddenly changed to the Waco Twin Peaks Restaurant located at 4671 South Jack Kultgen Expressway in Waco for May 17, 2015.” A Lorena policeman “explained that the COC is run by the Bandido (sic) OMG.” Lorena police told the DPS “that the COC is where other MCs are required to join & pay dues to the Bandido (sic) OMG to be able to operate in Texas.” The Lorena police, “felt like the change of the meeting location was purposely done to show support for the Bandido (sic) OMG in the Waco area to the Cossacks MC.” “The following week” Texas DPS agents began to collaborate with the Waco PD about the forthcoming **Confederation of Clubs & Independents** meeting 6 weeks in the future. Waco’s gang intelligence detective had heard the same thing – that the COCI was coming to Waco. “On April 16, 2015,” the DPS in Waco was informed by Waco police “that the Bandidos OMG was enroute (sic) to Legends Cycles located at 3201 Interstate 35 Frontage Road in Waco to confront the owner which is also the President of the local chapter of Cossacks MC.” DPS agents, including Frost, “responded to the area of Legends Cycles along with marked & unmarked Waco PD units. Special Agents & Officers conducted surveillance of the area; however, no threats materialized.” “On April 16, 2015 at approximately 8:00 P.M., DPS Texas H.P. Trooper Jeff Wachendorf observed forty to fifty members of the Cossack MC turning into the parking lot of Twin Peaks. Trooper Wachendorf notified the Waco PD & the McLennan County Sheriff’s Dept who responded & began monitoring the area. No known disturbances occurred.”

**Frost Begins Researching:** There was, however, a disturbance at the Twin Peaks on April 23 that “resulted in the arrest of a Cossack MC member for unlawfully possessing a handgun on a licensed premise. A bandana containing a padlock was also seized from the same individual during this arrest.” Frost & other DPS agents “began researching the **Coalition of Clubs** meeting on May 17, 2015. Special Agent Frost located an internet domain name <http://unitedclubsofwaco.org> . In researching this website’s calendar of events, Special Agent Frost observed on May 17, 2015 from 1:00 PM to 2:00 PM a **Region 1 Confederation of Clubs & Independents** meeting at Twin Peaks in Waco. This information

corroborated that of (the) Lorena PD.” “Special Agent Frost also observed that the website’s colors are that of red/yellow or gold which are consistent with that of the Bandido (sic) OMG. Special Agent Frost observed under the ‘Member Clubs’ link a laundry list of known MCs with Bandido (sic) OMG being at the top. Special Agent Frost did not observe the Cossacks MC as being a member.”

**The SOI:** “On May 1, 2015, a bulletin was released to LE detailing the escalating tension between the Bandidos OMG & the Cossacks MC. This bulletin detailed the incident in the City of Lorena as well as others throughout the State. This information corroborated information being received by (Lorena gang investigator) Rogers & Special Agents. Detective Rogers spoke with a source of information who stated the Cossacks were planning to attend the **Confederation of Clubs & Independents** meeting at Twin Peaks in Waco. The Cossacks planned to address the issues between the 2 clubs.” The reference to a “source of information” in the Waco area with knowledge of what the Cossacks planned to do 15 days in the future is interesting. The Aging Rebel has been told the name of the SOI but has been unable to confirm it. “On May 8, 2015, Special Agent Frost, Detective Rogers & DPS CID Lieutenant Steven Schwartz met to discuss the **Confederation of Clubs** meeting. During this meeting, Detective Rogers (of the Lorena police) advised that due to the rising tension between the 2 groups & the fact that information being received that both groups will be in attendance the Waco PD was planning on having a police presence in the area during the meeting on May 17, 2015 at Twin Peaks to deter criminal behavior.”

**Study And Observe:** “Lieutenant Schwartz & Special Agent Frost agreed that DPS CID Special Agents should also be in the area to conduct surveillance, gather intelligence & be able to readily respond in the event that the Waco PD needs assistance. It was also agreed that DPS CID Special Agents would request the assistance of the Texas HP in performing routine patrol duties on the major roadways in the area such as Interstate 35.” At a meeting “on May 14, 2015” Lorena, Texas gang expert Rogers, who was apparently handling an SOI inside the Cossacks, “advised that the Waco PD would have marked patrol units consisting of 2 officers each in the parking lot & around the Twin Peaks area. These officers would be Waco PD Special Weapons & Tactics officers. Detective Rogers further advised that the Waco PD Street Crimes Unit would be in the area working routine patrol duties in case assistance is needed.” “Rogers explained that information was being obtained that someone rented Twin Peaks for this meeting. Detective Rogers explained that the Waco PD had attempted to contact Twin Peaks management on several occasions; however, has had little to no cooperation. Special Agent Frost agreed to attempt to contact someone in the Twin Peaks Corporate office in an attempt to gather that information.”

**Final Planning:** It was at that May 14 meeting that the DPS agents “decided that the use of the Dept’s drop camera would be beneficial to supplement Special Agents (sic) ability of physical surveillance.” After the meeting concluded, “Special Agent Frost attempted to make contact with Twin Peaks CEO Randy Dewitt. CEO Dewitt did not answer & Special Agent Frost left a message explaining Special Agent Frost had some questions about Twin Peaks Waco upcoming event.” An hour later, “Frost received a phone call from Twin Peaks General Counsel. Special Agent Frost explained the **Coalition of Clubs** meeting that was expected to take place on 05-17-15 at Twin Peaks & LE had concerns about some members of certain motorcycle gangs who may be attending.

Special Agent Frosts' question was if the entire establishment was to be rented out for this meeting. General Counsel explained that the Twin Peaks in Waco was owned by a franchise & that they would make contact with that franchise attorney to make contact with Special Agent Frost." An hour after that, Waco Twin Peaks owner "Jay Patel called Special Agent Chris Frost & identified himself as the owner of Twin Peaks in Waco. Special Agent Frost explained to Patel that it was DPS CID'S understanding that there was to be a meeting of the Coalition of Clubs on 05-17-15 & asked Patel if the entire Twin Peaks establishment was rented out for this meeting. Patel explained to Special Agent Frost that the Coalition of Clubs had only rented out the patio area of Twin Peaks. Special Agent Frost explained to Patel that there was rising tension between 2 motorcycle gangs that could possibly both be in attendance at this meeting. Patel explained to Special Agent Frost that Patel was told to expect approximately 4 hundred (400) bikes & due to this Twin Peaks had hired 3 security guards. Special Agent Frost advised Patel to call Special Agent Frost if any threats are received or heard of by Twin Peaks." "Once information was confirmed that only the patio was rented & the main portion of the restaurant would be open to the public, a decision was made to have Special Agents working in undercover capacity to be inside the restaurant. These Special Agents would be inside the restaurant to conduct surveillance & gather intelligence from inside the restaurant. A CID Operational Plan was completed & will be maintained at the Waco DPS CID Office."

**May 17:** "On the morning of 05-17-15 at approximately 7:00 A.M., Special Agent Frost deployed the DPS CID covert camera. The camera was placed in the public right-of-way & was positioned to capture the patio area of Twin Peaks." "On 05-17-15 at about 10:30 AM, Special Agent Frost drove by Twin Peaks parking lot & observed what appeared to be employee's only at the restaurant. Special Agent Frost proceeded to the DPS CID briefing location which was the Flying J Truck Stop parking lot located at 2409 South New Road in Waco. Once at the Flying J, Special Agent Frost met with Special Agents Cory Ledbetter, Justin Overcast, Mark Gerik, Chris Dale & Lieutenant Schwartz. While in the parking lot, Special Agents observed a large number of unknown MC or OMG members walking around & through the parking lot conducting what appeared to be counter surveillance. Special Agents moved the briefing to another location." "During the briefing, surveillance observed a large group of Cossack members at Twin Peaks in & around the patio area. A decision was made during the briefing by Lt Schwartz not to send undercover Special Agents into the restaurant. A decision was made for Special Agents to pair up to conduct surveillance of the area & gather intelligence. Special Agent Frost & Dale were in one vehicle with Lt Schwartz, Special Agent Ledbetter & Overcast were paired & Special Agent Gerik & Detective Rogers were paired." "Special Agents entered the parking lot of the Central Texas Market Place & began monitoring Twin Peaks at around 11:40 A.M. on 05-17-15. At approximately 12:24 P.M. Special Agent Gerik reported gunshots from the parking lot of Twin Peaks. Special Agents responded & assisted the Waco PD in securing individuals, administering first aid & securing the perimeter around Twin Peaks."

**Waco firefighter fired after gun arrest, officials learn of alleged Bandidos affiliation** - Oct 16, 2015 – *Texas* - By Tommy Witherspoon; [www.WacoTrib.com](http://www.WacoTrib.com) - A 13-year veteran with the Waco Fire Dept was fired this week after he was arrested on a weapons charge in May & officials learned he is a member of the Bandidos motorcycle gang who was shot last year in a bar fight between rival biker groups. Waco Fire Chief John Johnston fired — or indefinitely suspended - firefighter Bill Dudley for what the chief listed as a multitude of violations of state law & city policies, including "unlawfully carrying a weapon while being a member of an outlaw gang." Johnston declined comment on the matter, saying Dudley has the option of appealing the indefinite suspension through the city's Civil Service process. He said it would not be proper to comment on a potentially pending personnel situation. Dudley, 33, had been a Waco firefighter since July 2002. Johnston placed him on administrative leave with pay on May 15, 3 days after Dudley was arrested in Crowley for unlawfully carrying a pistol, a misdemeanor. After a 4-month internal investigation, Johnston notified Dudley in a letter dated Tuesday that he was being fired. Dudley, contacted by phone, denied being a member of the Bandidos & said there are many items in Johnston's termination letter that he disputes. He declined additional comment & referred other questions to his attorney, Mitch Dooley, of Forth Worth. "I represent him on something that is completely unrelated to what's in that letter. I represent him on a misdemeanor gun charge," Dooley said. "Other than that, I haven't seen the letter & I don't know what it says. He is not facing any charges up here as far as being associated with a street gang."

**In Johnston's letter to Dudley**, obtained by the Tribune-Herald through a Texas Public Information Act request, the chief summarizes at least 5 skirmishes Dudley reportedly was involved in along with other Bandidos he was riding with on those occasions. Dudley also was fired for not obeying rules & regulations; being absent from work without good reason; failing to notify the Dept within 24 hours of his arrest; using poor judgment that reflects negatively toward the fire Dept & the city; & demonstrating poor moral character by associating with &/or being a member of a known criminal street gang as defined by the Texas Penal Code, according to the termination document. Johnston reports that Crowley police pulled Dudley over May 12 after seeing his truck cross 3 lanes of traffic without signaling. Dudley told the officer he had a gun, which the officer reported that he saw in open view. The officer checked Dudley's license & criminal history during the stop. The computer had Dudley's license flagged with the warning "use caution" & indicated he was a Bandido, according to Johnston's letter. The information was entered in LE data bases by the Fort Worth PD & prompted the officer to call for backup. "The Crowley PD arrested you because you were unlawfully carrying a weapon in plain view while being a member of the 'Bandido' gang," Johnston's letter states. "While you were being questioned, it was observed by the police that 2 motorcycle riders traveling westbound were continually staring at the situation as they drove by the scene. The police officers searched your car while you were in custody. They discovered items in your console that supported the Bandidos." Johnston's letter notes the Texas Dept of Public Safety has identified the Bandidos as a criminal street gang. "Police cannot enter a person's information into the gang data base because they 'think' a person may be part of a gang," Johnston wrote to Dudley. "There must be strong evidence to support & demonstrate a person is a member of the gang." A Crowley police sergeant called Johnston on May

13, the day after Dudley's arrest, to tell him Dudley had been arrested, was still in jail & that he is a member of the Bandidos. The letter indicates a woman called the Dept that morning & said Dudley was sick. "Because you were in jail, you failed to show up to work ... Being in jail does not qualify for sick time benefits according to city policy," the letter says. Dudley was arrested in Crowley 5 days before the Twin Peaks shootout in Waco involving members of the Bandidos & Cossacks that left 9 dead & 20 wounded or injured.

*Neither Dudley*, who lives 50 miles north of Waco, nor his attorney would say if Dudley was at Twin Peaks in Waco on May 17. The letter also lists a Dec 2014 incident at Gator's Jam Inn bar in Fort Worth in which Dudley was shot in the chest, a rival biker was killed & another Bandido was wounded. Three Bandidos were charged in the incident, according to a report in the Fort Worth Star-Telegram. Dudley, who was hospitalized, was not charged. However, he misled fire Dept officers about his injury, the chief's letter alleges. "You told the deputy fire chief a person came up to you with no reason & pulled a gun & shot you & you did not know why this occurred," Johnston wrote. "Because we were unaware of the Gator Bar incident & did not have any reason to doubt your statement or have enough information to ask you the right questions, you flew under the radar. It wasn't until the internal investigation took place that we discovered there was more to your explanation than you provided. You were not forthcoming with information." In April 2014, the chief's letter alleges, Dudley was involved in a fight at the Electric Cowboy Bar. One of Dudley's "biker friends" got into an argument with the doorman about "the bar being biker friendly or not," according to the document. Dudley's friend started fighting with the doorman. "To aggravate & complicate the situation further, you jumped on the doorman's back to assist your biker friend," Johnston wrote. Dudley was cited by the Fort Worth PD, & the chief said Dudley failed to report the citation, as required by city policy.

*The letter also alleges* that in Sept 2013, Dudley & his "fellow bikers terrorized some individuals in a car by chasing them & shooting at their car" in Fort Worth. The chief noted that there are different versions about how the incident started. "However, the fact is that your group escalated the problem by pursuing the individuals & used a deadly weapon instead of notifying the police. If you felt the other party was at fault, you should have taken a license plate number & called the police instead of taking the law in your own hands," the letter states. The chief notes that during that month, Dudley was off work & on city injury time because he had a broken leg but was riding a "heavy motorcycle." The letter also alleges that Dudley was involved in a fight in Joshua, Texas, in August 2013. "No charges were made because no one would press charges or cooperate with the police on what happened," according to the letter.

**Mongols MC Legal Nightmare Continues** - Oct 16, 2015 – *Calif. U.S.A.* – By The Aging Rebel; [www.AgingRebel.com](http://www.AgingRebel.com) - Yesterday afternoon, just under the 30-day legal deadline, Assistant United States Atty Christopher Brunwin gave notice that he was going to appeal the dismissal of a case called United States versus Mongols Nation. A month ago, Fed District Judge David O. Carter dismissed the Oct 2013 indictment that was the basis for the Mongols Nation case & Brunwin is appealing that decision. Brunwin hasn't yet filed a brief in the appeal. He is simply announcing that he thinks Carter's 23 page ruling contains reversible legal errors. Notice of appeal in a Fed court is usually made within ten days of a ruling. The appeal will be made to the Ninth Circuit Court. Appeals to the Ninth Circuit are the slowest in the Fed system. The average time between notice of appeal & a judgment is about 18 months. About 75% of all appeals to the Ninth are decided solely on the basis of briefs submitted by the opposing lawyers without legal argument. The Mongols are represented by Los Angeles attorneys Joe Yanny & Elliot H. Min. For the last 7 years, Brunwin's co-counsel in the crusade against the Mongols has been Stephen R. Welk. Welk is the head of the asset forfeiture division of the U.S. Attorney's office for the Central District of California. Appeals are expensive & the decision to appeal Carter's dismissal would not have been made by either Brunwin or Welk. The decision to appeal would have been made by either Central District of Calif U.S. Atty Eileen Decker or someone higher in the chain of command in the Justice Dept. Decker is a former Los Angeles Deputy Mayor who assumed her current job 3 & a half months ago.

*The Clothes Police:* The most recent racketeering case against the Mongols began with a case called U.S. versus Cavazos et al. in Oct 2008. Brunwin indicted 79 members of the Mongols MC & the press release that announced the indictment contained this astounding passage: "The racketeering indictment seeks the forfeiture of the trademarked 'Mongols' name, which is part of the 'patch' members wear on their motorcycle jackets. "In addition to pursuing the criminal charges set forth in the indictment, for the first time ever, we are seeking to forfeit the intellectual property of a gang," said United States Attorney Thomas P. O'Brien. "The name "Mongols," which is part of the gang's "patch" that members wear on their motorcycle jackets, was trademarked by the gang. The indictment alleges that this trademark is subject to forfeiture. We have filed papers seeking a court order that will prevent gang members from using or displaying the name "Mongols." If the court grants our request for this order, then if any LE officer sees a Mongol wearing his patch, he will be authorized to stop that gang member & literally take the jacket right off his back." Taking the jacket right off the backs of Mongols has become a quest for the Dept of Justice. As has harassing the Mongols with legal proceedings.

*Not Constitutional Issue:* The constitutional issue of seizing the Mongols' name & symbols seems well resolved. Unless the name & symbols pose a real threat to somebody other than Brunwin, Welk & Decker they are legal expressions of opinion. Brunwin, Welk & Decker know it so the Gov't has been playing cute games around that issue for years. The point of the recent, Mongols Nation case has always been to seize the Mongols patch &, in turn, the patches of every other MC. It is a recurring theme in the global war on MCs. Various states in Australia, depending heavily on the coaching of "motorcycle gang experts" from the American ATF have actually banned the display of MC insignia. In Waco, Texas, a local prosecutor named Abel Reyna ordered the arrest of scores

of people on the basis of the symbols they wore even though there was absolutely no proof that any of them had committed any crime. In the Mongols Nation case, Brunwin & Welk sought a trial to prove that the Mongols MC was a criminal enterprise that used its insignia for criminal purposes. The Gov't's plan was to first, convict the club as a whole for racketeering & then start forfeiture proceedings to seize the club's name & patch. At the risk of oversimplification, Carter didn't allow the case to proceed because "nobody was going to jail." He ruled that the Gov't couldn't indict the Mongols as an "enterprise" for racketeering without also indicting a group who can be actually punished. He wrote that the Gov't had made "no meaningful distinction between the association Mongol Nation & the enterprise of the Mongols Gang," So with nobody to punish, there could be no case. It was as if the Gov't had indicted the stars or the sea. But, after 8 years, the Gov't still won't give up. The quest continues. Sometime in the next month or so, Brunwin will write a brief that explains the errors in Judge Carter's reasoning. Until then, the only thing that is certain is that the Gov't does not intend to stop until some judge somewhere rules that police can actually detain you for your fashion choices & if the police don't approve of them they can literally rip your clothes off.

**Reyna Versus R.S. Gates** – Oct 16, 2015 – *Texas* – By The Aging Rebel; [www.AgingRebel.com](http://www.AgingRebel.com) - This week, a Texas Assistant Atty General named Lance Kutnick, ruled that McLennan County District Atty Abelino "Abel" Reyna violated the Texas Public Information Act in one of the numerous sideshows that have plagued coverage of the Twin Peaks Massacre: The alleged bargaining of bond reductions for defendants in the case in return for the defendants' acquiescence to hold harmless agreements. Houston attorney Paul C. Looney started it. On May 31, Looney issued a press release that made a disturbing claim that in hindsight seems more plausible now than it did then.

**Looney Accusation:** "Earlier today," Looney wrote, "detainees in the Jack Harwell Detention Center in Waco were told that in exchange for bond reductions, they must sign a document stating the Waco police 'had the right to arrest the inmate & that he/she will not file a lawsuit against McLennan County &/or the City of Waco.'" "On the 2-week anniversary of the 'shootout at high noon' at the Twin Peaks restaurant between motorcyclists & LE officers, at least 170 people remain detained on \$1 million bonds. "This latest information was reported to an attorney representing at least one of the detainees. 'It appears the public defenders office in McLennan County is involved in this scurrilous activity,' said Paul Looney, a Houston attorney with Looney & Conrad, P.C. 'I've never seen anything like the lawlessness that the authorities have perpetrated on these people & now to add insult to injury they are trying to cover their own tracks in exchange for bond. I will be in the reception area of the McLennan County D.A.'s office tomorrow morning at 8:30 with the intention of not leaving until we have the issue of bond resolved.'" "They know these people aren't dangerous or they wouldn't be offering the bond reductions & they know the police & the D.A.'s office have violated the law & now they are trying to hold people hostage until they agree to waive their rights. It's unconscionable," said Clay S. Conrad, Looney's law partner." In an email to the Houston Press, Reyna wrote, "It is totally false, ridiculous, & sad that someone would make such baseless allegations."

**Mulligan:** The next day Looney issued a second press release that stated: "It has been determined the District Attorney's office

was not involved in yesterday's attempt to get defendants to waive their rights of litigation in exchange for bonds...That entire debacle was orchestrated by McLennan County private attorney Brittany Lannen...Her behavior in this matter is bizarre, unprofessional, unethical & unappreciated by all of the attorneys representing defendants, by the McLennan County District Attorneys office, & by the McLennan County court staff. Her behavior will be reported to the State Bar of Texas for investigation this week." Lannen publically called Looney's accusation "reprehensible." In private texts she described it as "stupid" & "horseshit." And some short time later the entire brouhaha should have been over but it wasn't.

**R.S. Gates:** A "public information activist" named R.S. Gates immediately requested screenshots of the text messages between Waco Assistant District Atty Michael Jarret & Lannen. He still hasn't gotten them. He received a transcription of a text message from Jarret to Lannen on September 12 & earlier this month he got a screenshot of 2 texts between Lannen & Jarret on May 31. In that screen shot, in apparent reference to Looney, Lannen wrote: "My thoughts exactly. There is now an intel bulletin going out to all LE about his involvement in the protests Sunday. I'll explain when you are ready. No rush." In the same screenshot, Jarret replied: "The negotiation of bonds is based on the legal factors a court can consider. I would never ask someone to forfeit anything when agreeing to bonds, with the exception of bond conditions prescribed by the court." But after more than 4 months Gates still hasn't gotten screenshots of the entire conversation between Lannen & Jarret. He is entitled to see them. Under Texas law the screenshots of both sides of the conversation are public documents. On Oct 9, Kutnick wrote Reyna, "The McLennan County District Atty has 4 days after receipt of this notice to cure the alleged violation(s). The McLennan County District Atty office should provide a screenshot of the entire text message to Mr. Gates." Reyna ignored the order. This week the Texas Atty General ruled Reyna was in violation of the state's Public Information Act. Technically, Reyna can be fined \$1,000 & be sentenced to 6 months in jail. That doesn't seem likely. But the whole sideshow, from May 31 until now, does illustrate the back room nature of justice in Waco.

**11 Motorcycle Club Members Arrested At Brain Cancer Fundraiser** – Oct 18, 2015 – *New York* – By Ben Yakas; <http://gothamist.com> - Eleven motorcycle members were arrested after cops raided a brain cancer fundraiser in Long Island this weekend & found numerous guns & drugs. Hundreds of members of the Pagan's MC & other like-minded motorcycle groups gathered at Duffy's Ale House in Lindenhurst on Sat night to celebrate the club's 50th anniversary & the reopening of the Pagan's Long Island chapter, & to raise money for 13-year-old Thomas Napoli, who is battling brain cancer. Newsday reports that cops raided the "*Bikers for Thomas Strong*" event that night, & ended up seizing 5 handguns, 1 rifle, 1 shotgun, marijuana, cocaine, crystal meth, a billy club & 3 vehicles. Eleven members from 5 different motorcycle groups were arrested altogether. The following members of the Pagan's MC were arrested, police say:  
Michael John Parsnip, 42, of North Carolina, was charged with 2 counts of Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance 4th Degree, 3 counts of Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance 7th Degree for possessing crystal meth, cocaine, & morphine.  
Jason Lucian Craft, 39, North Carolina, was charged with one count of Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance 4th Degree

& 3 counts of Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance 7th Degree for possessing crystal meth, cocaine, & morphine.

Boudewijn Rob, 35, North Carolina, was charged with 2 counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd Degree for possessing 2 loaded firearms.

Kenneth Reynolds, 34, North Carolina, was charged with 2 counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd Degree for possessing 2 loaded firearms.

Adam Sockriter, 28, Delaware, was charged with one count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd Degree for possessing a loaded firearm & 2 counts of Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance 7th Degree for possessing crystal meth.

**SWAT team raids Iron Horsemen location** - Oct 19 2015 – **Ohio** - By Rich Jaffe; <http://local12.com> - In Sept 2015 Local 12 News reported about a new biker clubhouse established by the Iron Horsemen in Lower Price Hill. That clubhouse on West Eighth Street looked different in October than it did in Sept. Cincinnati has long been the territory of the Iron Horsemen. Call them a club, call them a gang, call them whatever you want; they've been a long-time problem for LE. The clubhouse in Lower Price Hill represented a bold effort by the Horsemen to extend their reach & stake a claim on the community, right up until when a swat team raided it. The Iron Horsemen's new clubhouse underwent a rather sudden transformation. Gone is the big black Iron Horseman logo from the fence. Gone is the Vic's Brew & Cue sign from a famous Mount Carmel biker shootout. Gone is the bike off the roof & much more. The redecorating was the result of a raid by Cincinnati police, the SWAT team & ATF & FBI agents, serving a search warrant on the property. Capt. Paul Nuedegate with Cincinnati police told Local 12 News, "They are not just a weekend motorcycle club that does Toys for Tots at the end of the year; that they are an organized criminal outfit that engages in drug trafficking, meth amphetamine trafficking." At the biker clubhouse, police took William Francis Meeker into custody. They described him as a "wannabe" Horseman. He already had convictions for assault & robbery. Police said he had a .38 special with him when they arrested him. When Local 12 News was at the clubhouse Sept. 10, we talked with neighbor Michelle Hodgetts & asked what it was like living next to the Iron Horseman. She said,

"Loud, there's probably some illegal stuff going on over there, that's what I heard. But it's mostly the motorcycles revving at 3 o'clock in the morning." Police also agreed illegal stuff was going on inside the club. So after the raid Wednesday, Oct. 14, agents paid a visit to the main Iron Horsemen Clubhouse in California on the city's east side. They told the 20 or so assembled members & Horsemen leaders why they raided the Lower Price Hill location & explained the federal law known as "Violent Crime in Aid of Racketeering." The raid no doubt brought a sigh of relief to neighbors like Michelle, "Nobody around here's happy that they're here," said said, "because of who they are." For the last few years, as Local 12 News has reported, the Horsemen were involved in a turf war with what authorities called a rival club, the Detroit Highwaymen. While the Highwaymen, following a similar raid, disbanded, according to Local 12 sources they may be in the process of making a Cincinnati comeback.

**Alleged Hells Angel gets prison for beatings** - Oct 22, 2015 – **Massachusetts** - By Julie Manganis; [www.SalemNews.com](http://www.SalemNews.com) - A man reputed to be the "Sgt at arms," or enforcer, for the North Shore chapter of the Hells Angels motorcycle gang was sentenced to state prison Thu after admitting to violent assaults on 2 men last Dec. James T. "Jamie" Costin, 51, of Lynn, will serve 11/2 to 31/2 years in prison for the Dec. 20 assaults outside the Fat Cacus, a restaurant & bar on Route 1 in Lynnfield. One of the men was left with disfiguring facial injuries, prosecutor Lynsey Legier said during Thursday's hearing before Salem Superior Court Judge David Lowy. The damage, which included severing the man's lower lip & breaking 2 of the man's teeth, appears to have been caused with a large metal ring Costin was wearing that evening, said the prosecutor. But while police, with a search warrant, found 3 rings in a cigar box at Costin's home that tested positive for human blood, the blood on those rings did not match that of either victim in the Fat Cactus incident, said the prosecutor. Later, investigators listened to a recording of Costin, held at Middleton Jail without bail, instructing another man to get rid of a different cigar box, the prosecutor said. And the other victim, whose ex-wife is currently Costin's girlfriend, has been equivocal as to whether he recalls seeing a ring on Costin's hand that night. The 2 victims, along with a number of other Wakefield High School graduates, had gone to the restaurant to listen to a band of classmates following a funeral, Legier said. Costin & the ex-husband of his girlfriend ended up outside, smoking, when the conversation grew heated. A classmate, who was friends with the ex-husband, asked if everything was okay. Costin then turned on that man, eventually punching him to the ground & kicking him. That man required reconstructive plastic surgery & dental work, the prosecutor said. The ex-husband, meanwhile, was punched by Costin as he tried to intervene. A woman who was there with the ex-husband was pushed away & fell down a flight of steps, prosecutors have said. Had the case gone to trial, Legier told the judge, she would have sought to introduce testimony & photos that show Costin regularly wore large metal rings, & that it was a practice of Hell's Angels members to do so in order to avoid being caught carrying illegal weapons. Legier asked Lowy to impose a 3- to 4-year prison term, followed by probation, with anger management, alcohol treatment & a GPS bracelet. She pointed to Costin's record. In 2004, Costin, who had been an employee of the state auditor's office, was convicted of beating an off-duty Lynn police lieutenant inside a Lynn bar. But she also acknowledged the reluctance of one victim in particular to testify at trial. Costin's lawyer, Mark Miliotis, argued for a sentence of

one to 2 years, pointing to the 10 months Costin has spent being held without bail at Middleton Jail. He objected to references to Costin's purported Hells Angels ties, saying the incident came down to an unfortunate dispute over a woman. And he tried to counter the report of a plastic surgeon who treated one of the victims with his own report, by someone he described as a "cut man" who works in the boxing industry, suggesting that the injury was not as bad as described by the doctor. Lowy, however, suggested that if Costin wanted to go forward with a plea, he would have to admit to the charges as brought, including the count of assault & battery with a dangerous weapon, causing serious bodily injury. Costin agreed to plead guilty to that count as well as 2 counts of assault & battery with a dangerous weapon. The judge also ordered Costin to pay \$1,400 in medical bills for one of the victims.

**FCC Slashes 'Excessive' Inmate Calling Rates** – Oct 23, 2015 – *Washington D.C.* – By [www.CourthouseNews.com](http://www.CourthouseNews.com) - The Federal Communications Commission plans to slash inmate calling rates that can make a phone call cost up to \$14 per minute. Saying it has a mandate to ensure that phone call rates are "just, reasonable & fair," the FCC is taking steps to rein in the "excessive rates & egregious fees" for folks trying to stay in touch with loved ones serving time in jail or prison. "While contact between inmates & their loved ones has been shown to reduce the rate of recidivism, high inmate calling rates have made that contact unaffordable for many families, who often live in poverty," the FCC said. An interim cap of 21 cents per minute on interstate debit & prepaid calls was set in 2013 in response to a petition by Martha Wright, a grandmother from Washington, D.C., for relief from the exorbitant rates she was paying to call her grandson in prison, the FCC said. Cost data also began flowing from the inmate calling service providers in 2013, by FCC mandate. The data provided the basis for public comment on proposed reform, which continues with this action. The change lowers the cap to 11 cents per minute for calls from state & federal prisons, & provides tiered rates for jails to account for the higher costs of serving jails & smaller institutions, according to the statement. The caps cover the enhanced security requirements of inmate calling, & allow providers a reasonable return, the FCC said. They reduce the average rates for many inmate calls from \$2.96 to no more than \$1.65 for a 15-minute intrastate call for most calls, & from \$3.15 to no more than \$1.65 for most 15-minute interstate calls. The FCC also capped or banned fees, which can add nearly 40% to the cost of a single call, according to the statement. Commissioner Ajit Pai & Commissioner Michael O'Rielly opposed the new rule as exceeding the commission's legal authority. Pai discussed another problem in prisons: cell phones being smuggled in to be used in phone scams or other crimes. The new rates take effect 90 days after publication in the Federal Register in prisons, & 6 months after publication in the Federal Register in jails.

**Second suspect provided gun in 2014 Abilene murder** – Oct 28, 2015 – *Texas* – By Maggie Contreras; [www.KTXS.com](http://www.KTXS.com) - New court documents obtained by KTXS reveal a second suspect in a 2014 murder in Abilene allegedly gave a gun to the murder suspect. According to a search warrant from Sept, investigators believed Wesley Dale Mason, 39, gave a gun to John Gutierrez. Gutierrez is accused of beating Carey Rod Tate to death in an apartment on Musken St in Abilene in Dec 2014. He tied up Tate's body, stuffed it in a large dog crate also provided by Mason, & took the body to a remote location in Jones County, the search warrants said. Authorities said Tate also suffered a gunshot wound. According to court documents, investigators believe Gutierrez shot Tate with a gun provided by Mason while at the location in Jones County. Gutierrez was arrested in February on a murder charge. After Mason was arrested in Sept for tampering with evidence, human corpse, authorities said he called his live-in girlfriend to take the gun & get rid of it & other guns at a deer lease. Mason is also a suspect in an investigation of a stabbing at Logan's Roadhouse in December 2013. Officers at the time said Mason was described as the "Sgt of Arms" for the Bandido MC. Mason & the Bandido Pres are accused of stabbing 2 members of the rival Cossack MC. That case is set for trial in Dec.
